Recommended Action: Move that the Board execute Revenue Contract KC-070-23, Amendment A, with Washington State Department of Social and Health Services, Division of Aging and Long-Term Support Administration.	
Summary:	<p>This revenue contract KC-070-23-A with Washington State Department of Social and Health Services, Division of Aging and Long-Term Support Administration increased by \$258,164, increasing the contract total from \$793,122 for a new contract total of \$1,051,286 in Older American Act funds for the continuation of services to Kitsap County Seniors. The contract period remains unchanged, January 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024.</p> <p>This allocation represents the additional 20% of the total allocation of Older Americans Act funding to support services in Kitsap County.</p> <p>This contract will fund the following services for 18 months:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• legal services for 250 clients.• 7,000 hours of Information and Assistance services to 1,600 individuals.• 650 hours of counseling to 150 older adults and caregivers.• 35,000 congregate meals to 950 older adults and caregivers.• 50,500 home delivered meals to 500 homebound seniors and caregivers.• 320 hours of Nutrition Education to congregate and home delivered meal participants.• 95 assessments to 95 unpaid family caregivers; and• 600 hours for client investigations of Elder Abuse and concerns. <p>This revenue contract corresponds with the 2020-2023 Area Plan Update for Aging Services. Programs funded under this revenue contract in whole or in part include Non-Medicaid Case Management, Family Caregiver Support Services, Information and Assistance, Legal Services, Long Term Care Ombudsman, Mental Health, Nutrition Services (Congregate and Home Delivered Meals) and Medication Management Services.</p>
