

VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

JOB TITLE: Central Kitsap Community Council

DEPARTMENT: Board of County Commissioners

JOB SUMMARY:

Represent the citizens of Central Kitsap County in reviewing and making recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners on growth management issues such as: land use and zoning, public utility service delivery, transportation improvements, parks and recreation, design standards, public safety, taxes and fees, environmental protection, and other related matters. Members serve three-year terms with the exception of the college and high school student positions which are less than one year for one school year from September through the end of June.

JOB DUTIES:

Attend CKCC meetings, which are scheduled at least once a month. Function as part of an advisory team. Facilitate communication between the Board of County Commissioners and the residents of Central Kitsap. Assist with area-wide planning and land-use matters. Advise the BOCC on the expenditure of capital improvement funds within the boundaries of the Council's area. Perform other tasks as assigned by the BOCC.

SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be a resident of the Central Kitsap School District. Must be willing and able to attend monthly meetings and function as part of an advisory team.

TRAINING AVAILABLE:

An orientation and training will be provided by staff and council members.

RESPONSIBLE TO:

Kitsap County Commissioners

TIME COMMITMENT:

Monthly meetings are held on the first Wednesday of the month at 5 p.m. though the schedule may vary. Other meetings and training may occasionally be scheduled.
