This meeting was held in person at the Village Green Community Center as well as via Zoom Video Conferencing.

Welcome & Call to Order: Council Chair Kate Joncas called the meeting to order promptly at 6:30 pm.

- Initial Public Comment (2-minute limit per person)
 - o Question about rezone: she is against that place for that type of development. She read a detailed statement focusing on preserving the natural and rural character. Since this was a long statement Chair Joncas asked others who wanted to comment against the rezone for the same / similar reasons to not repeat in the interest of time.
 - o Ditto: he has school age kids who participate in sports, and yet opposes the rezone
 - o Ditto: added concern about affordable housing in the region and this (Raydient) development wouldn't help the lack of affordable housing types.
 - o Dana Schumacher: Kingston is 13 years late to incorporate. Kingston is being treated as a dumping ground based on the growth projections. We need affordable/accessible housing. Other successful small maritime towns limit height downtown (e.g., Friday Harbor, Poulsbo). UVC Taskforce representation didn't include any UVC residents.
 - o Ditto to Dana's comments: plus alluded to the tribes opposing the re-zone. He commented about Jon Rose not living here but having a disproportionate say in what happens here. He alluded to the tree removal appeal and referenced the seniors who enjoy the trees and are bed-bound so can only see nature thru their windows..
 - Question about the UGA / Comp Plan: he thought it was odd that we need to think / restrict single-family dwellings inside the UGA, meanwhile so many single family homes will be allowed in the Raydient Property..
- Introduction of members, including new members
 - o Barbara Waggoner has been replaced on KCAC by Breane Martinez
 - o Shep Grizwold will be replacing Glenn Malin as the Kiwanis Representative
 - o Jet Glavin-Woelke is resigning from the KCAC
- Commissioner Christine Rolfes Comments she was not present at this point

 - That's what is called Inclusionary Zoning and we don't have a hot enough housing construction market for that.
 - Are we already meeting our numbers b/c of Arborwood etc?
 - Yes (projected based on the buildout) in terms of residents. But we (Kingston / Kitsap County) aren't meeting our multifamily units requirement yet. This is a new requirement.
