# Kitsap County

- 283,200 residents (2023)

- Kitsap growth rate: 2.8% from 2020-23 (3.2% for Washington)

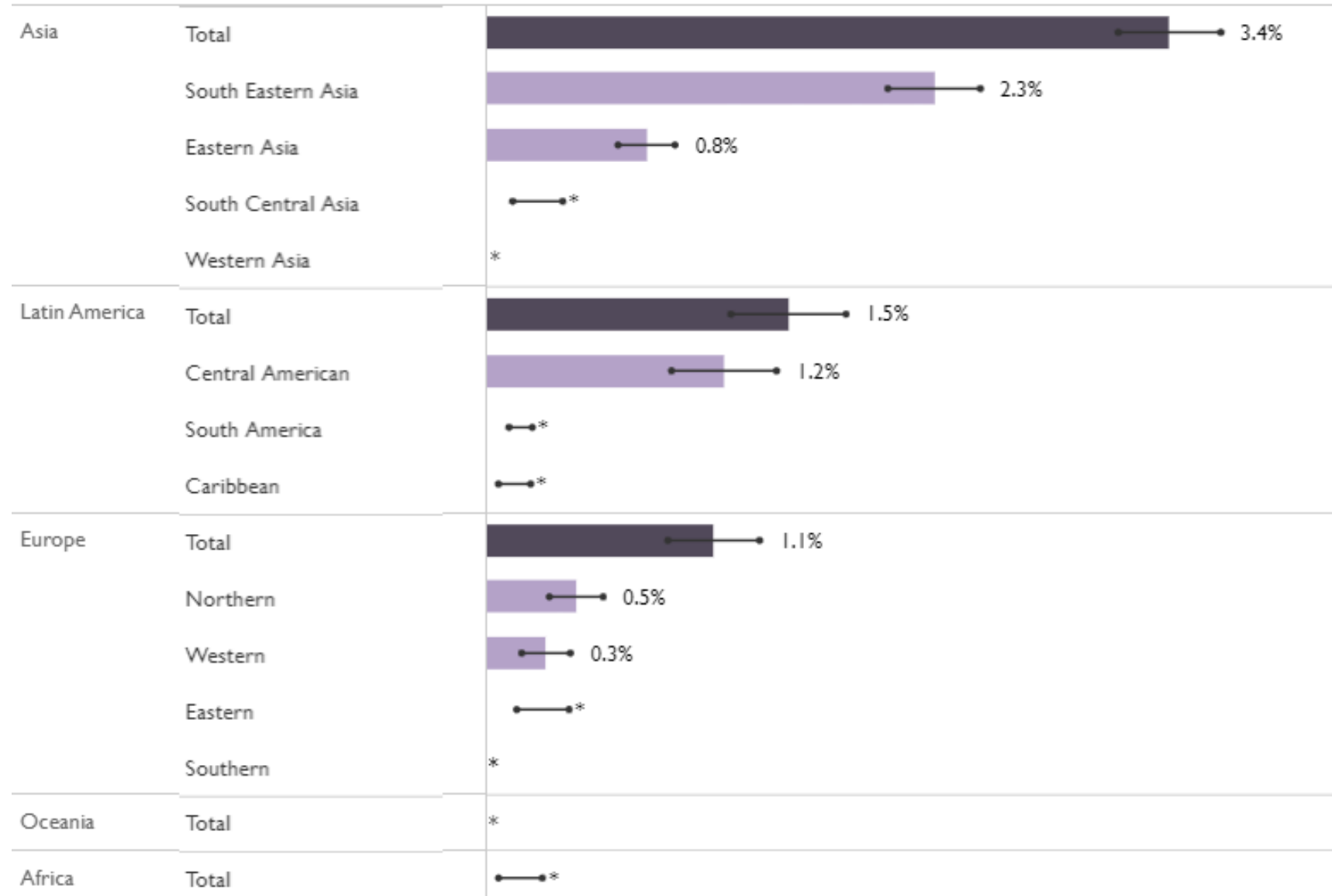

### Foreign Born Kitsap Residents (2018-2022)





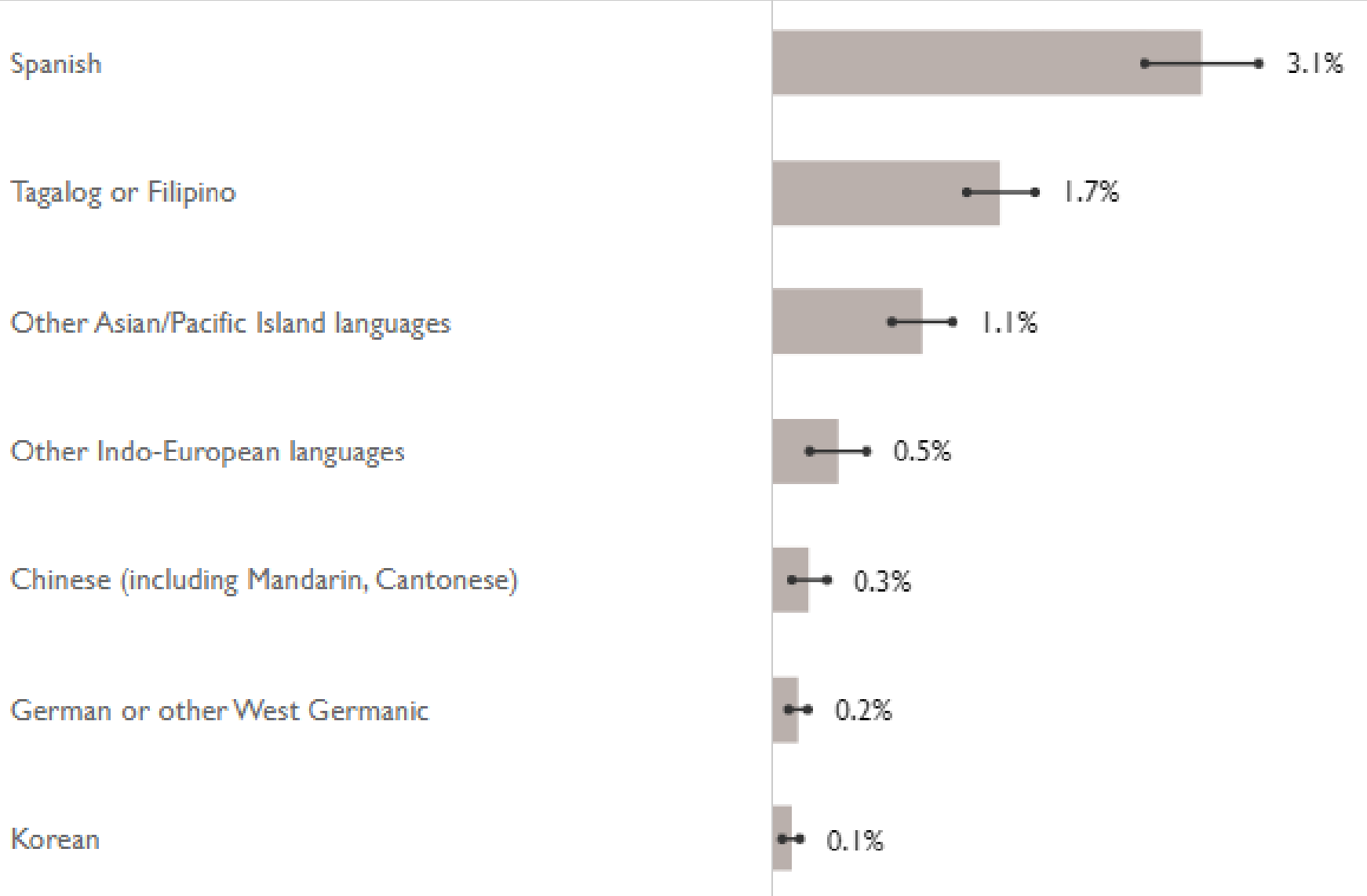

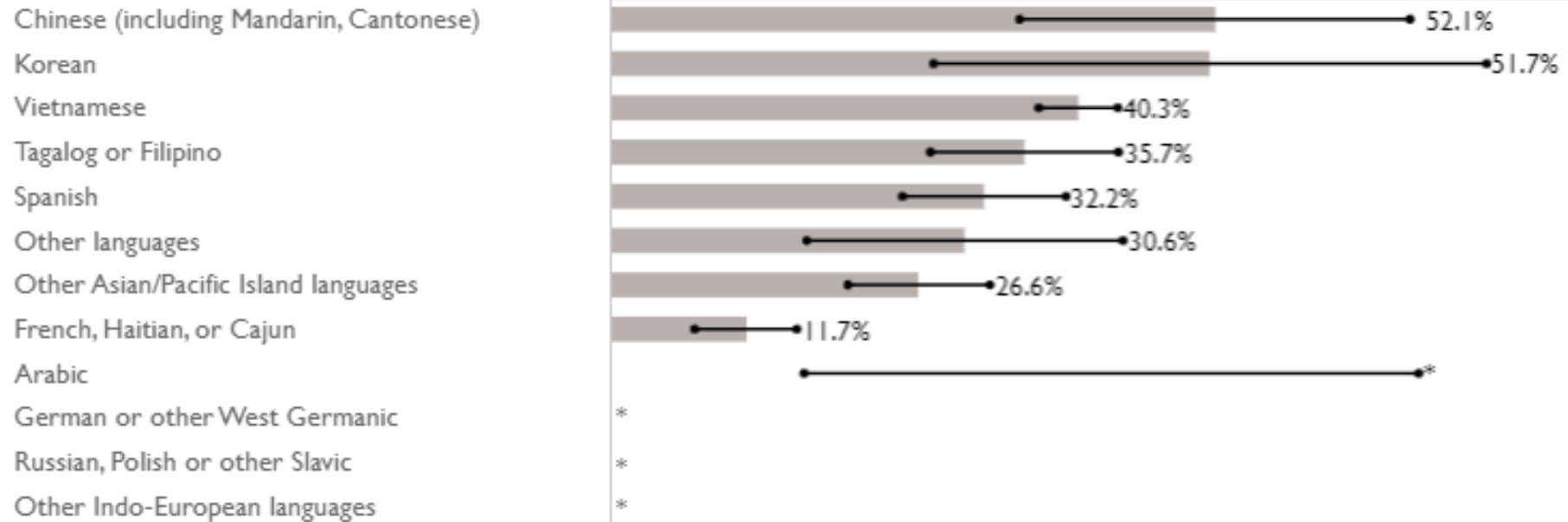
### Languages Spoken at Home in Kitsap from 2018-2022

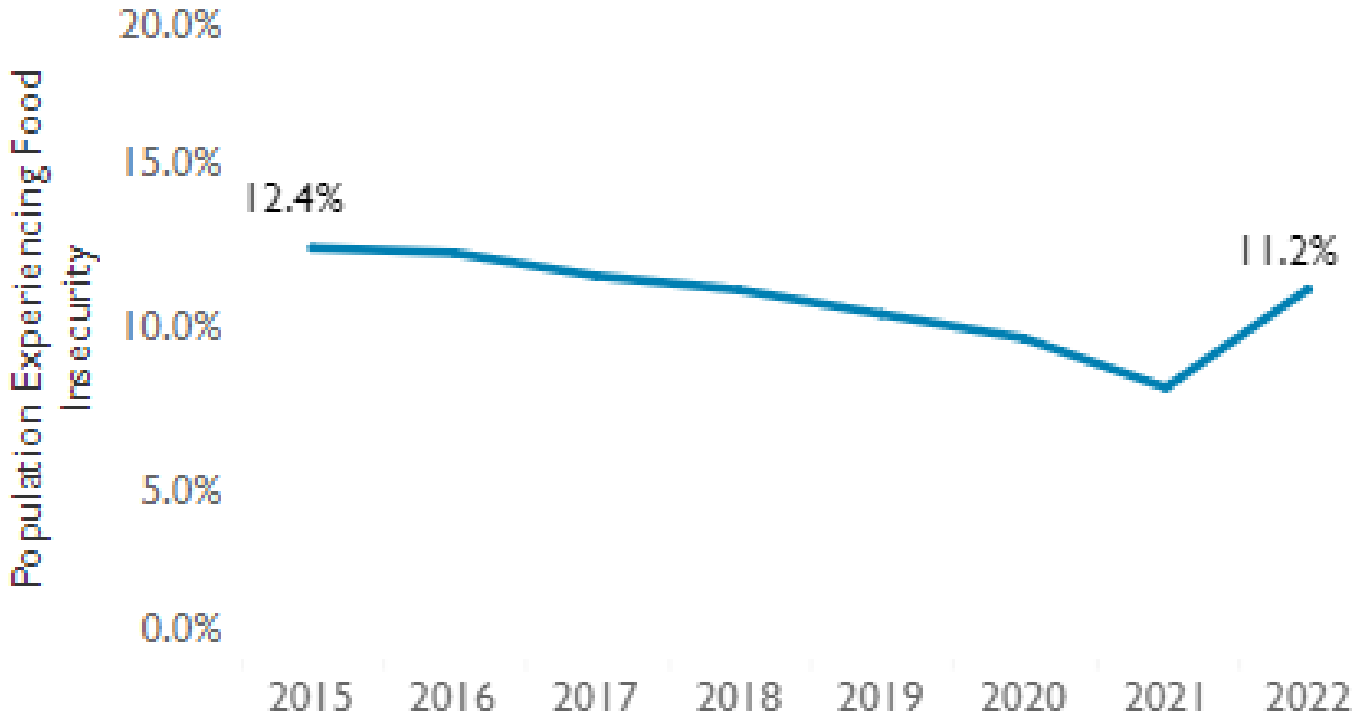

## Percentage of students



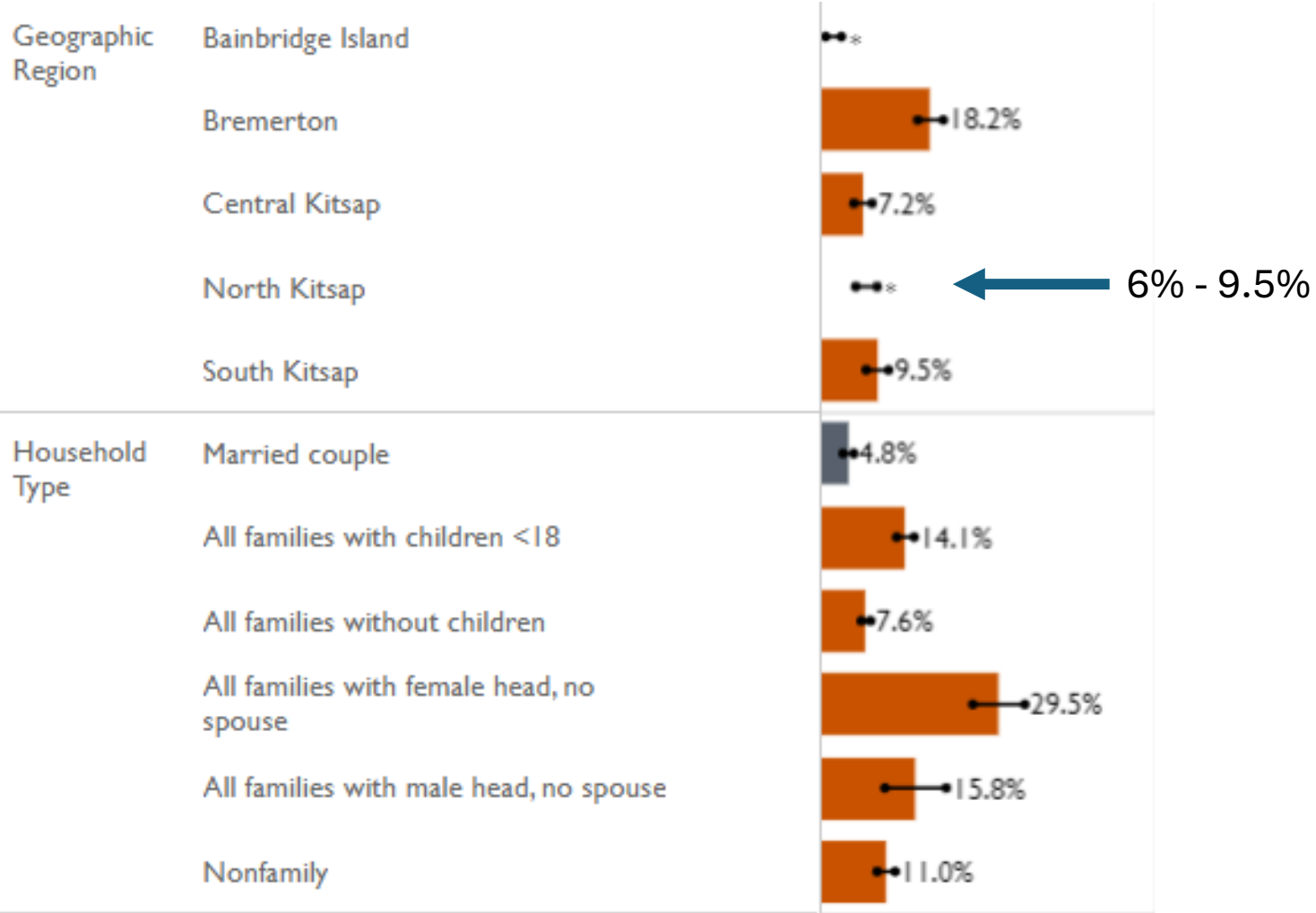

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Benefits

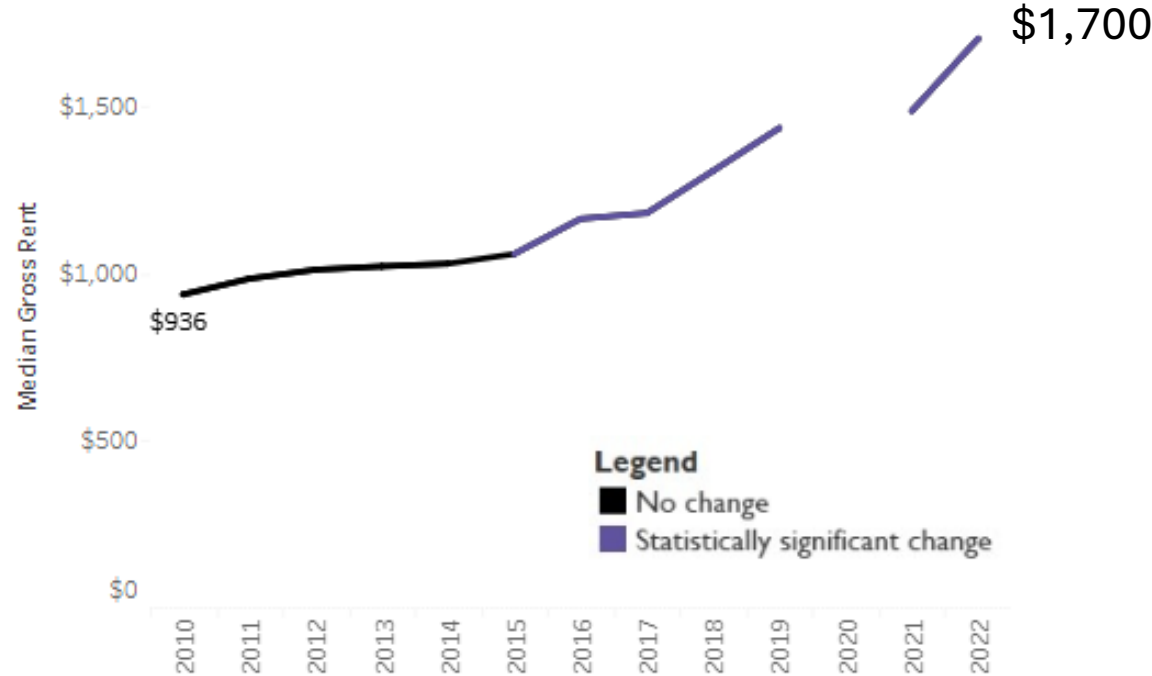

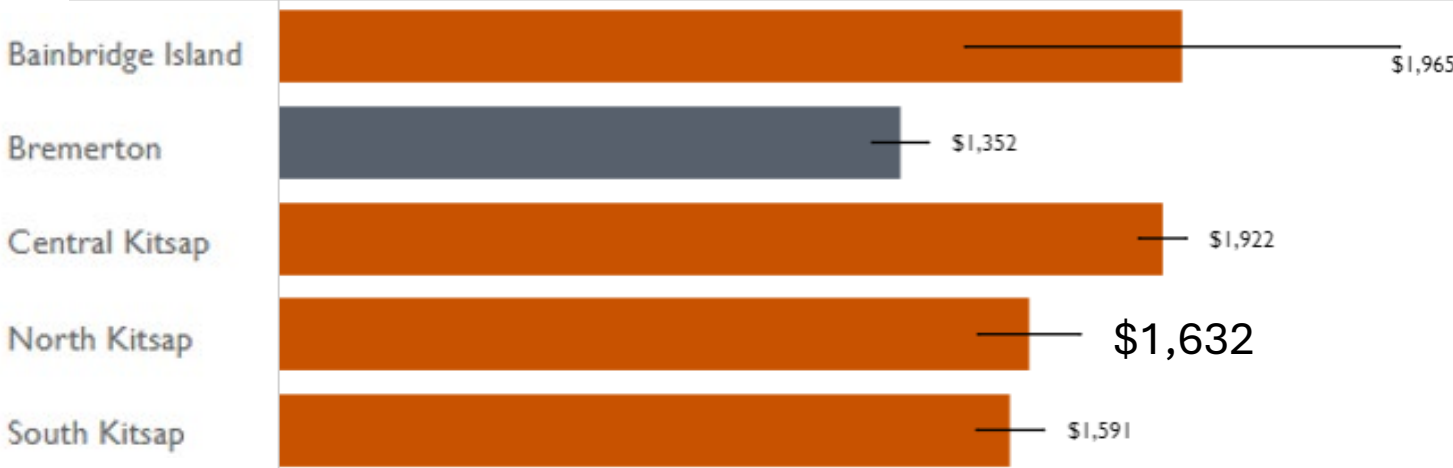

# Housing

- Occupied Housing

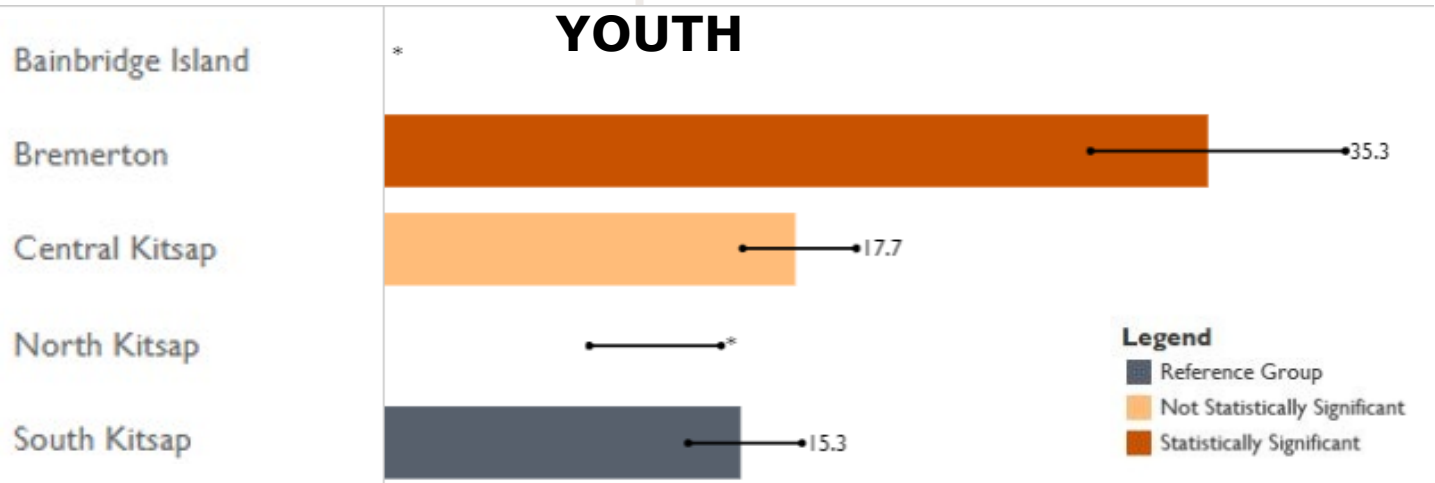

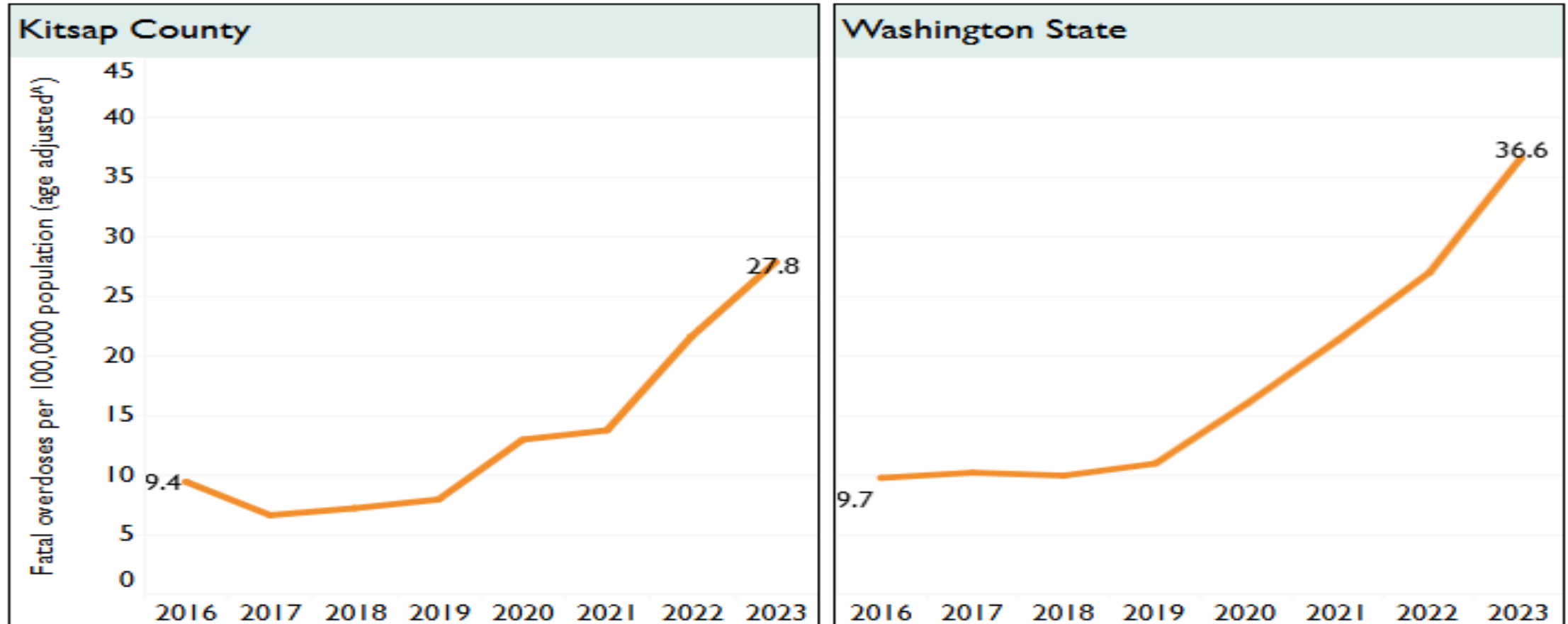

## Fatal Opioid Overdoses per 100,000 population (age adjusted)

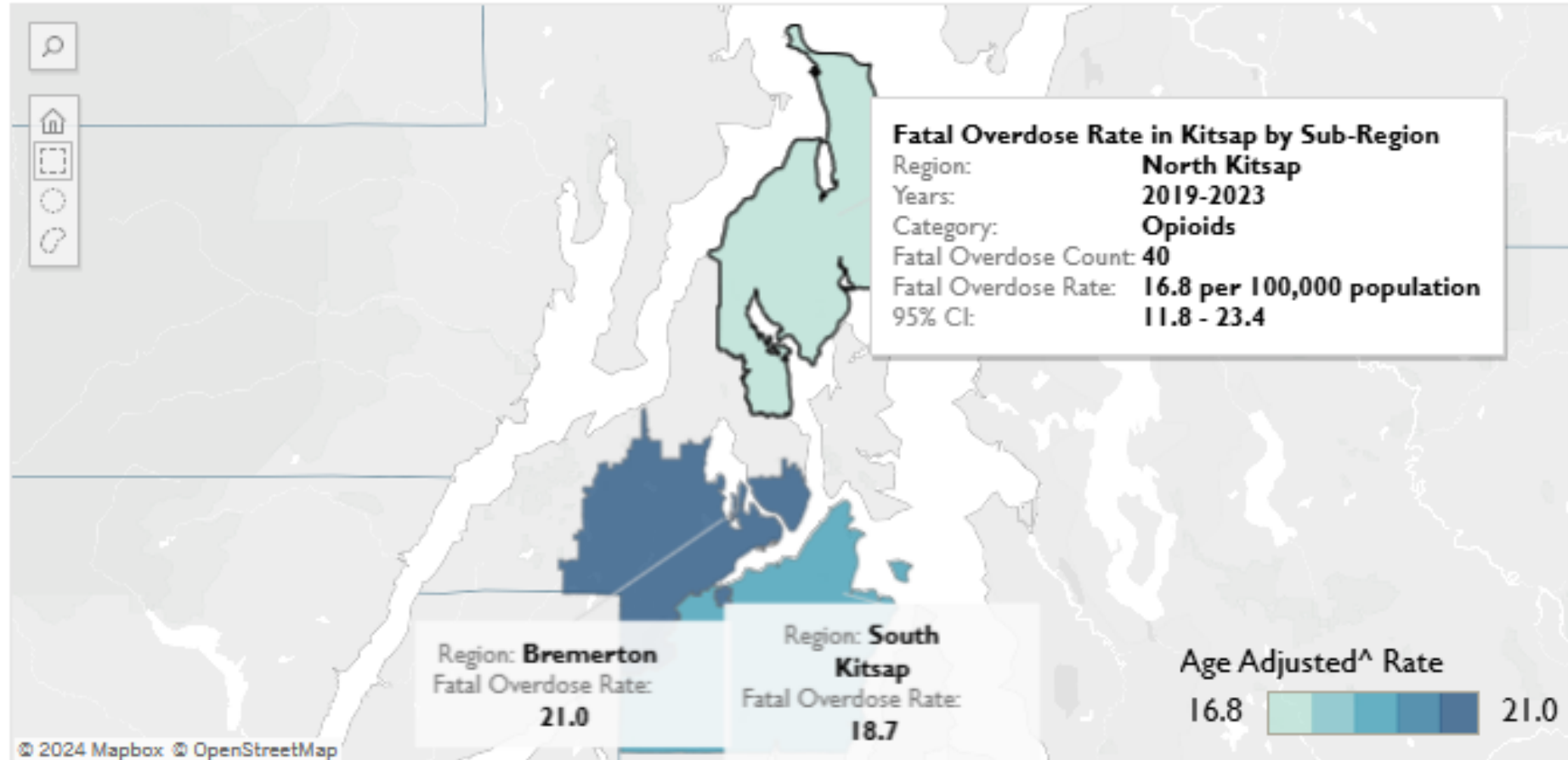

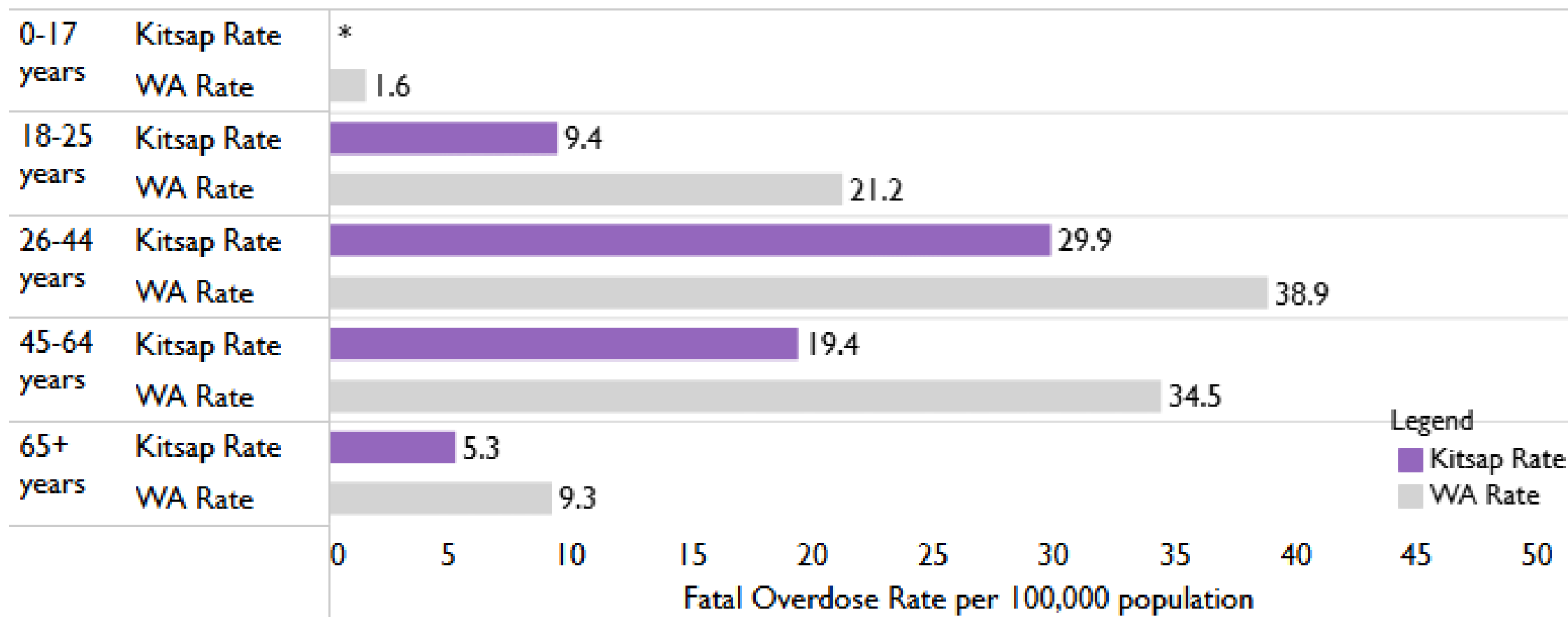
## Fatal Opioid Overdoses per 100,000 population (2019-2023)

## Fatal Opioid Overdoses per 100,000 population (2019-2023)

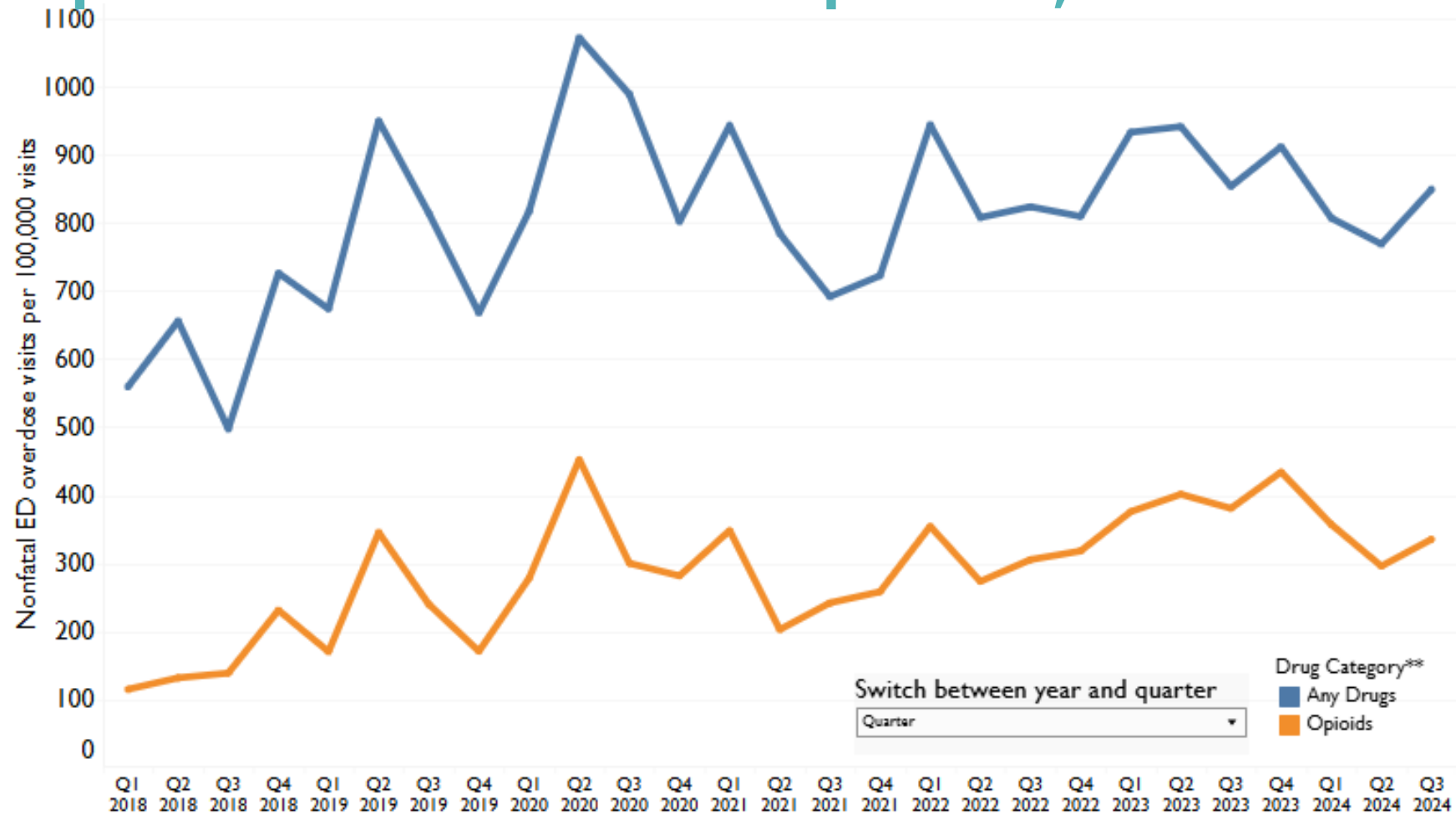

## Nonfatal Opioid Overdose ED Visits per 100,000 Visits

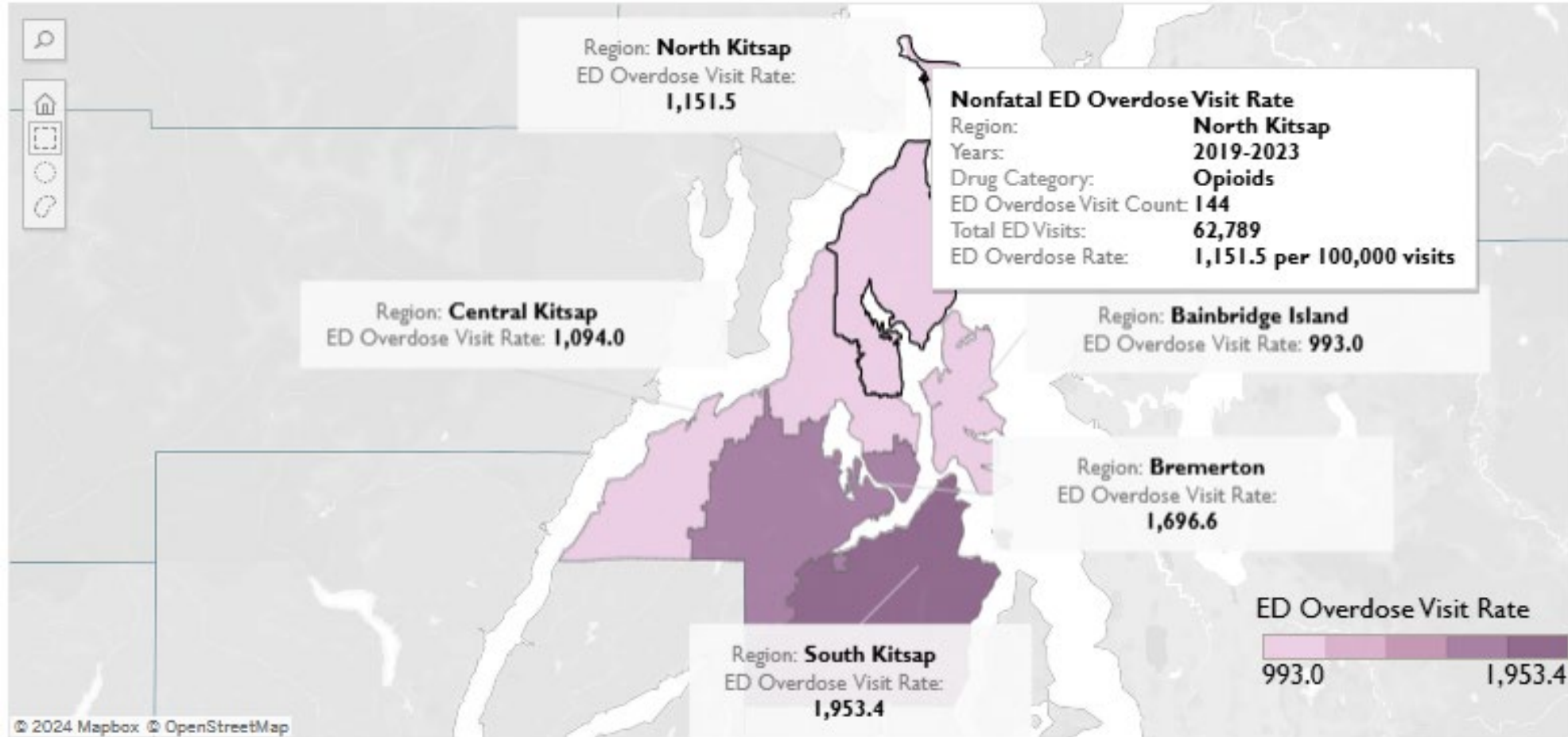

## Nonfatal Opioid Overdose ED Visits per 100,000 Visits (2019-2023)



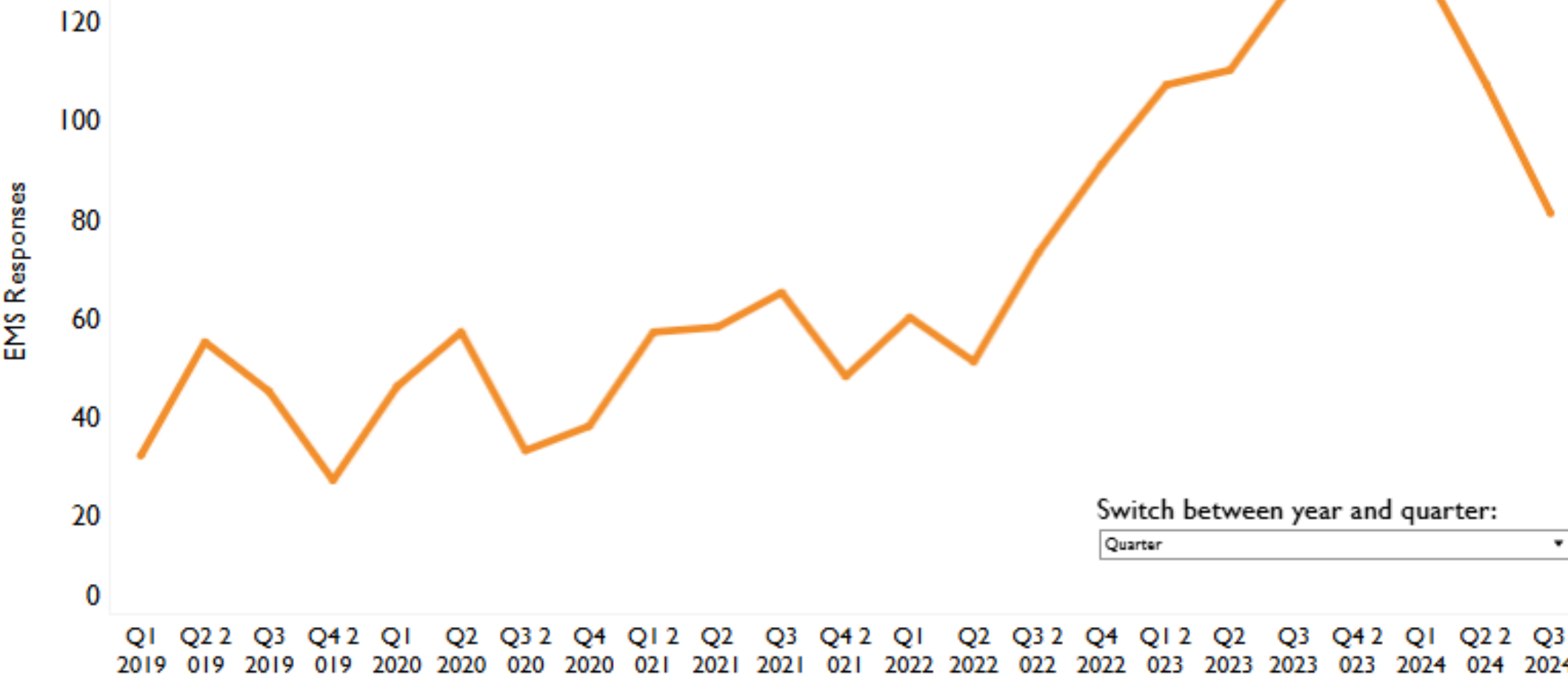

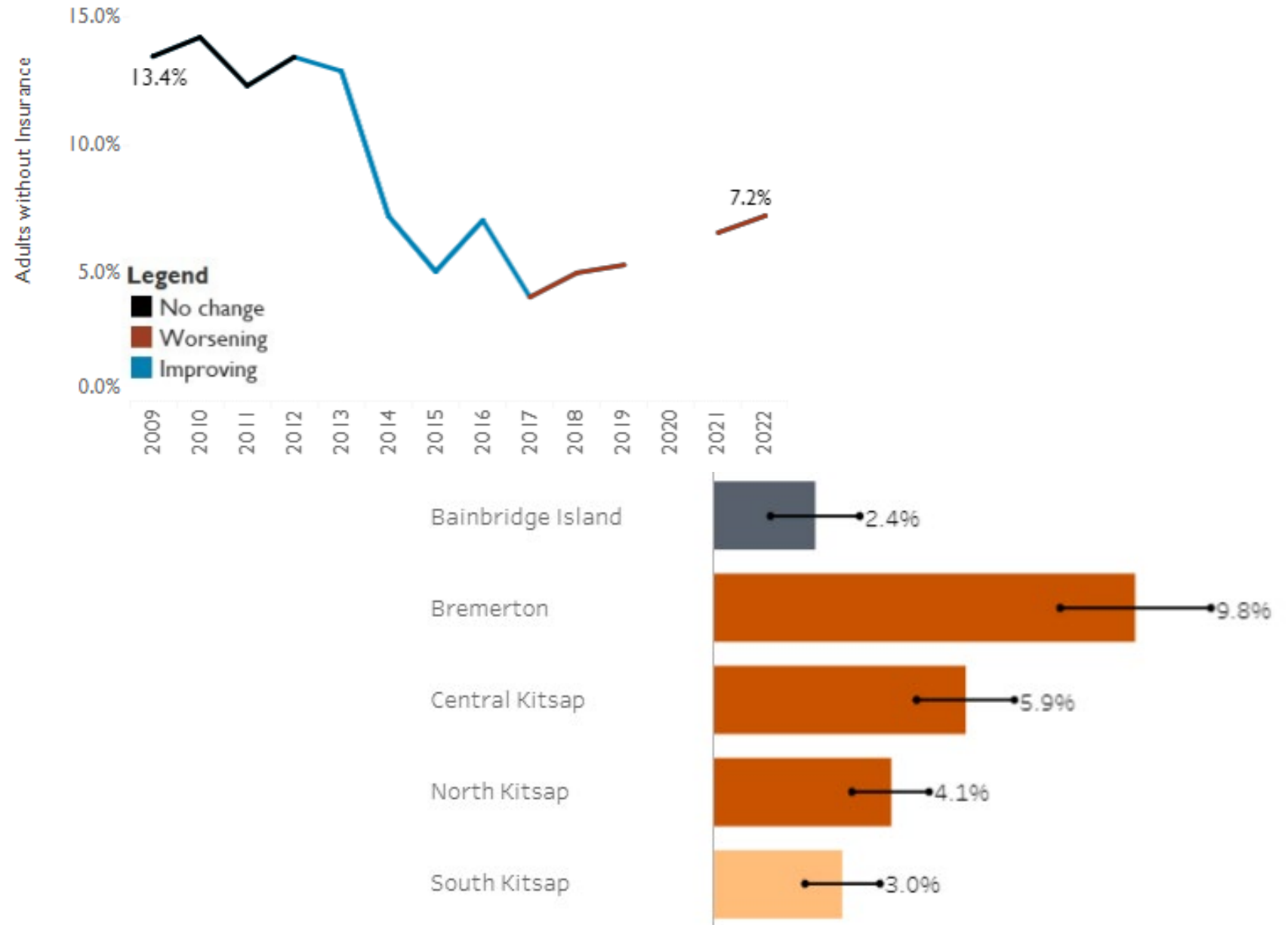

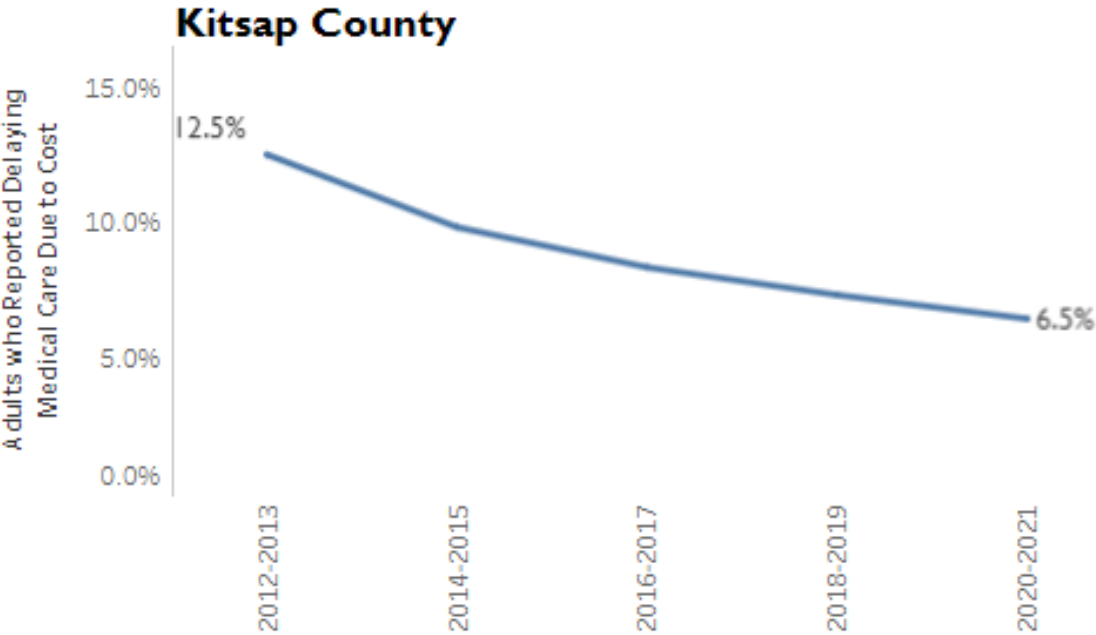
