

**Establishing the Kingston Citizen Advisory Committee**

**WHEREAS**, the Kitsap County Board of Commissioners advocates public participation and supports and encourages citizen involvement in all matters of County government; and

**WHEREAS**, many people in the Kingston community expressed a strong desire to have more input and better communication with their Commissioner and Kitsap County Staff; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Endresen selected a group of citizens to represent the broad interests of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the group of citizens who have been meeting as the Kingston Citizen Advisory Committee has submitted to the Board of Commissioners its recommendations regarding the creation of a Kingston Citizen Advisory Committee, including purpose, representation, terms, and duties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners are empowered to create advisory boards by the general governmental powers with which county legislative bodies are vested.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KITSAP COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS** that a Kingston Citizen Advisory Committee is established to enhance communication between Kitsap County government and the citizens of the area. The Committee is established under the provisions set forth in Attachment #1, *Kingston Citizen Advisory Council*. In addition, the Board affirms the appointments of the following individuals, listed on Attachment #2, *KCAC membership roster*, to serve on the committee.



