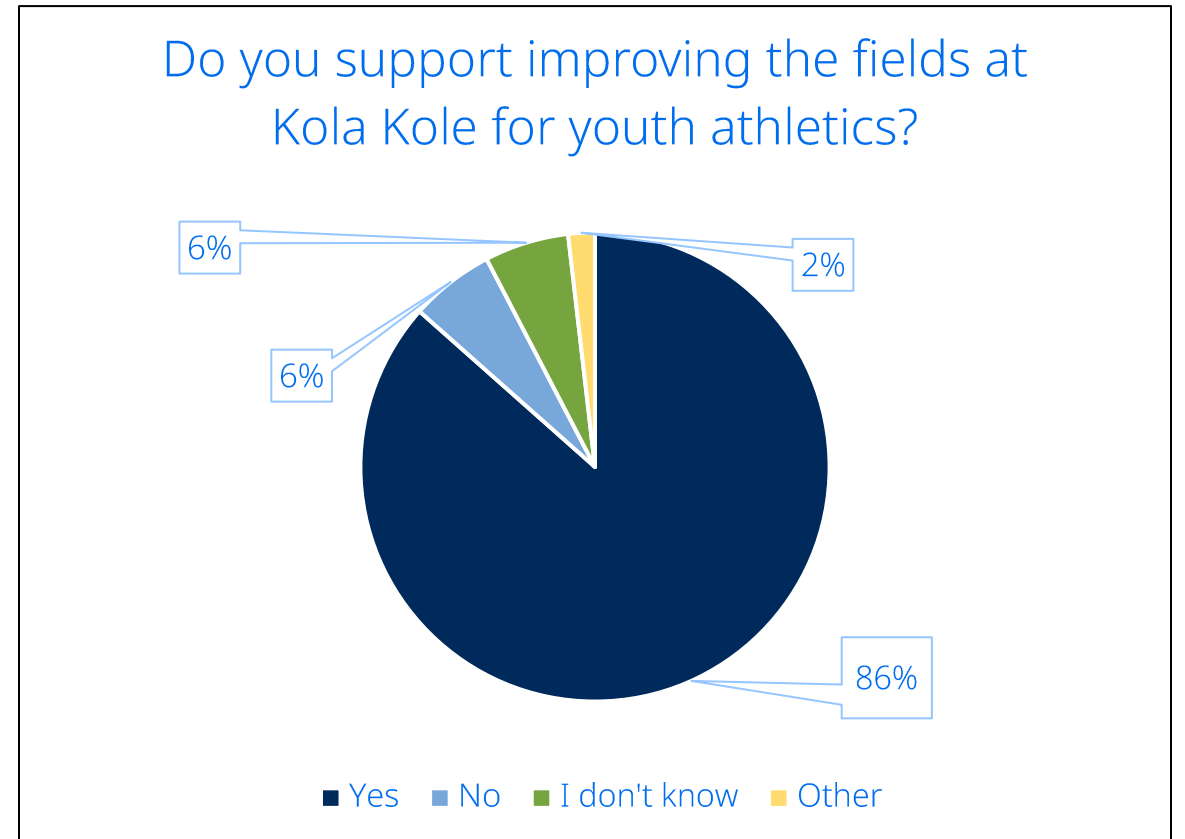
Kola Kole Park Community Survey

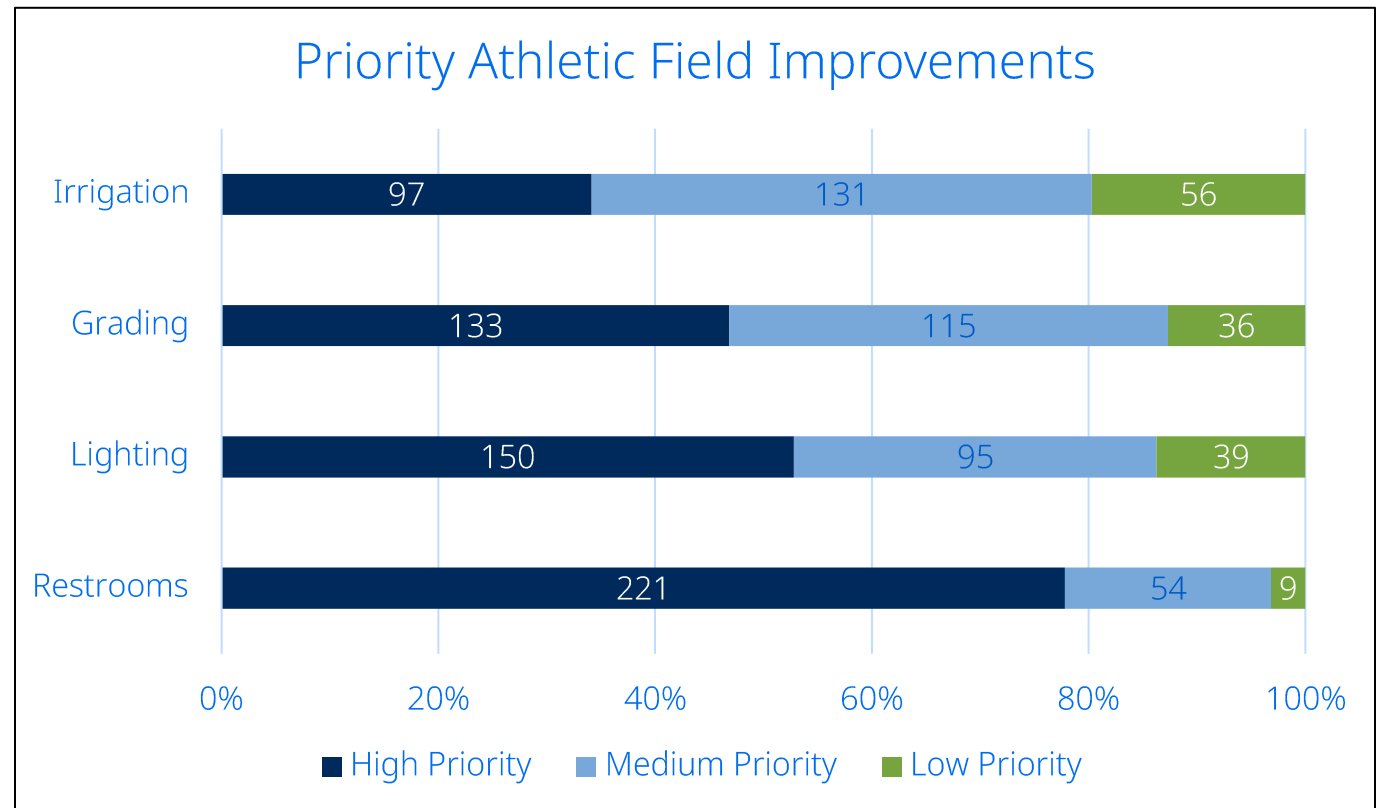
Athletic Field Improvements

- 283 respondents indicated they support improving the fields for youth athletics
- 19 respondents did not support athletic field improvements
- 25 respondents answered other/I don't know



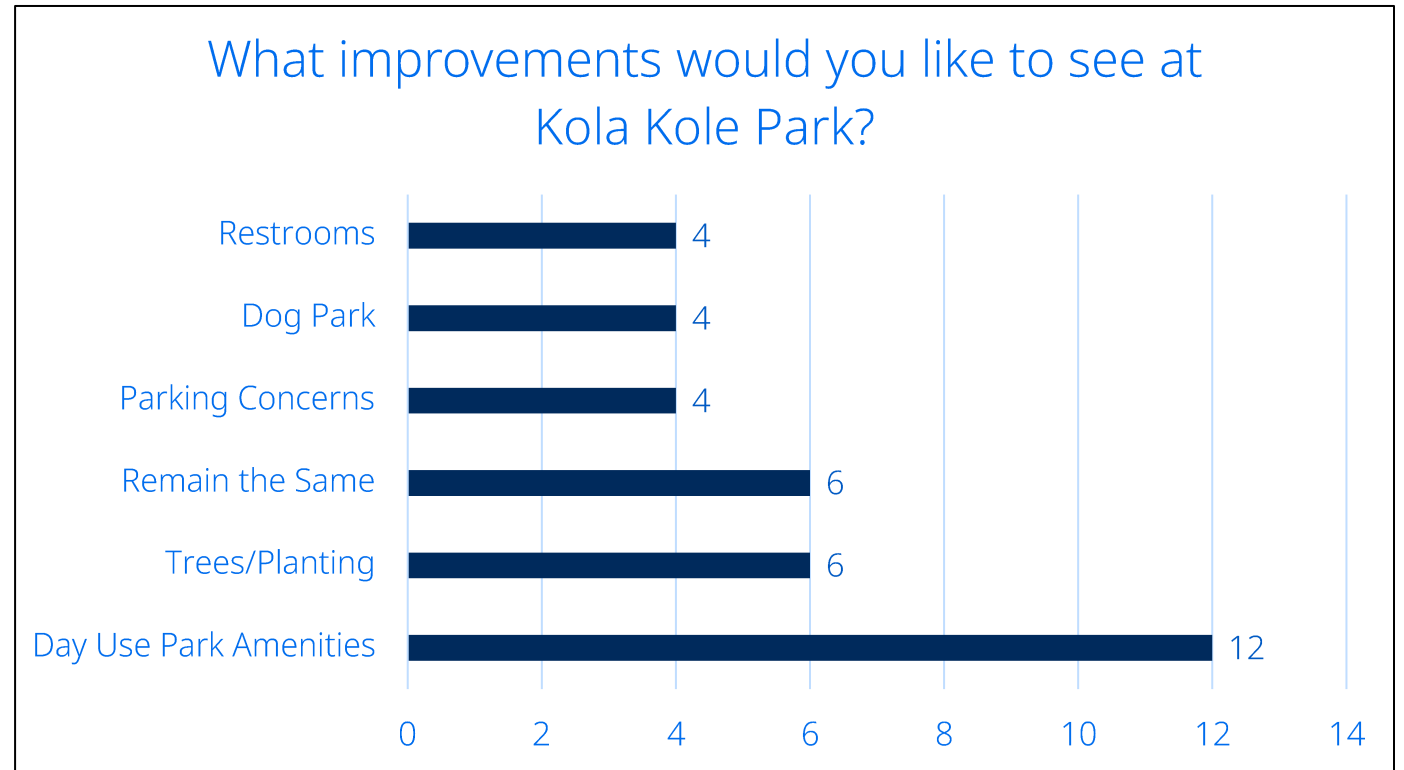
Athletic Field Improvements

- Participants were asked to rank the following athletic field improvements:
 - Restrooms
 - Lighting
 - Grading
 - Irrigation



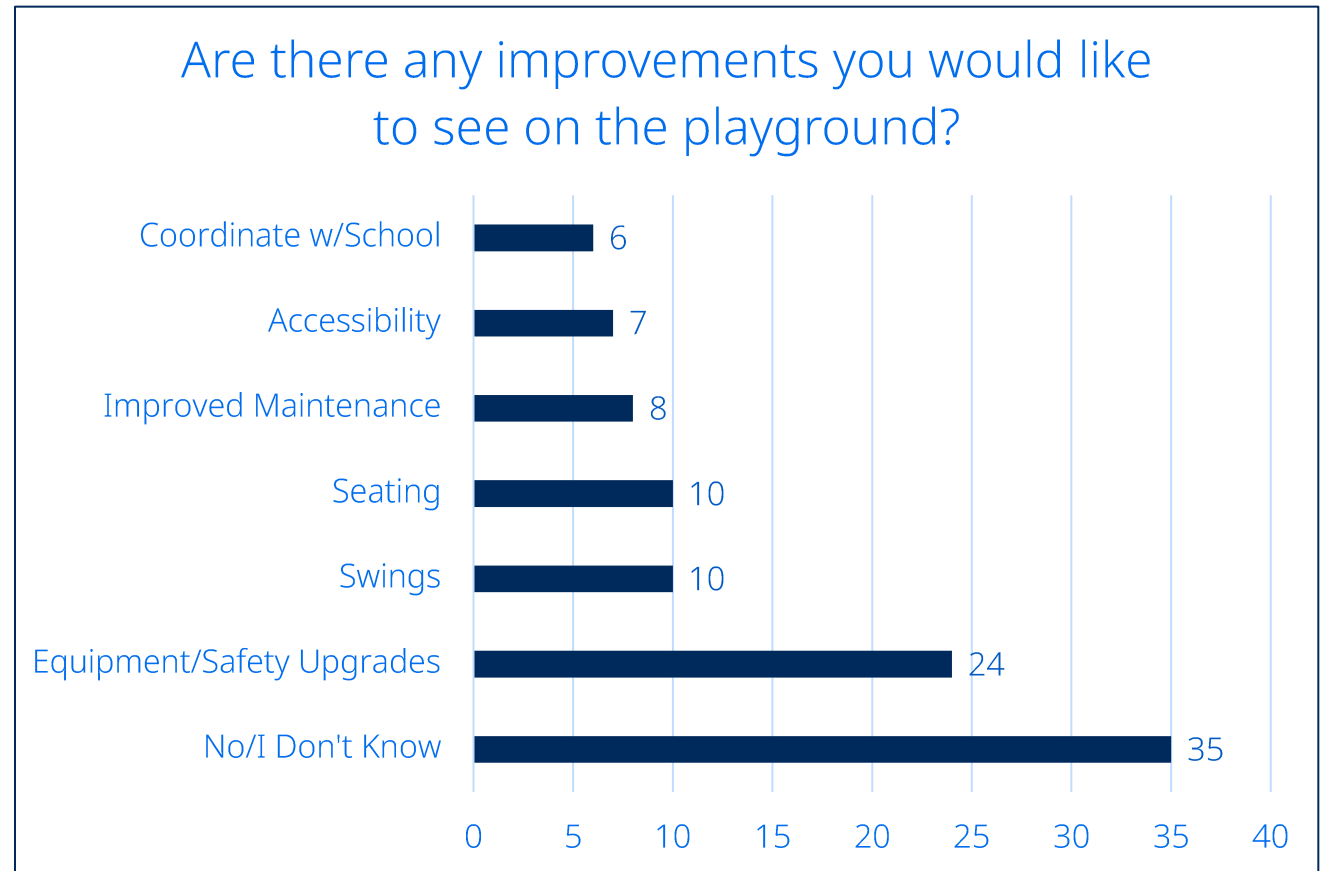
Other (Non-Athletic) Improvements

- Respondents not supportive of athletic field improvements would like to see the park serving a broader section of the community



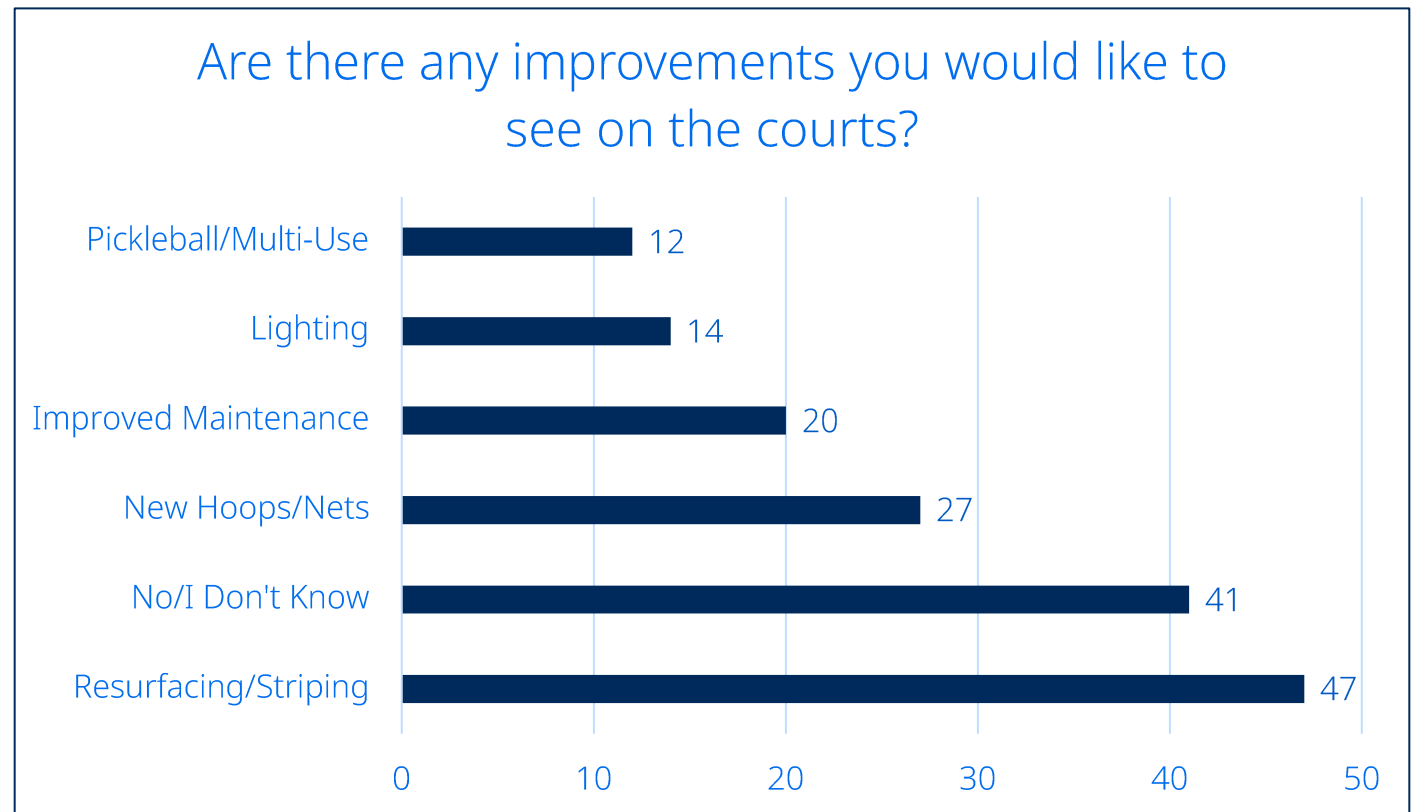
Playground Improvements

- 22% of respondents indicated there were no playground improvements they'd like to see
- Several features mentioned once or twice (slides, shade, fitness stations, toys for younger kids, fencing)



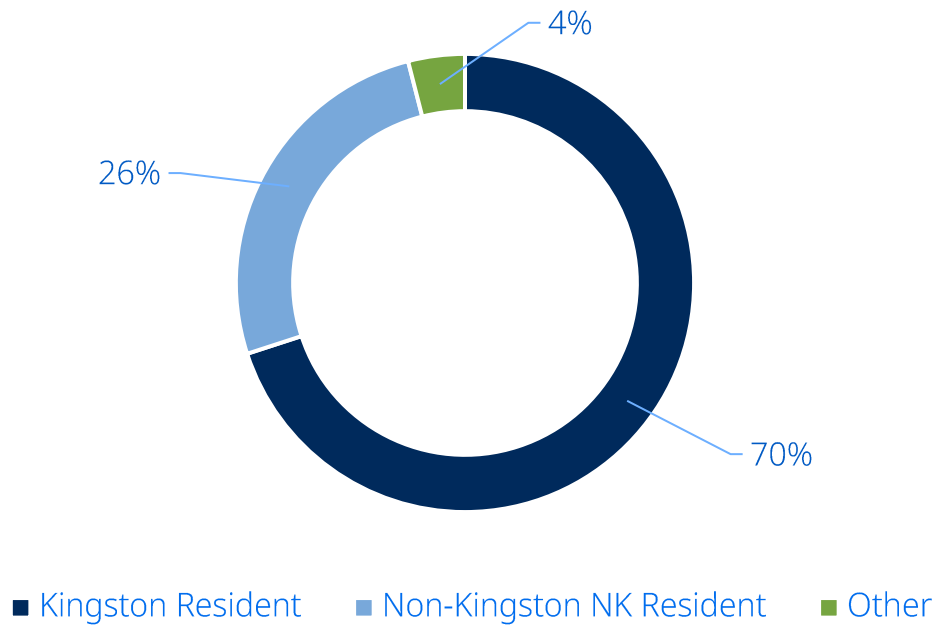
Basketball Court Improvements

- 31% of respondents indicated support for surfacing improvements, restriping
- 27% of respondents indicated there were no court improvements they'd like to see

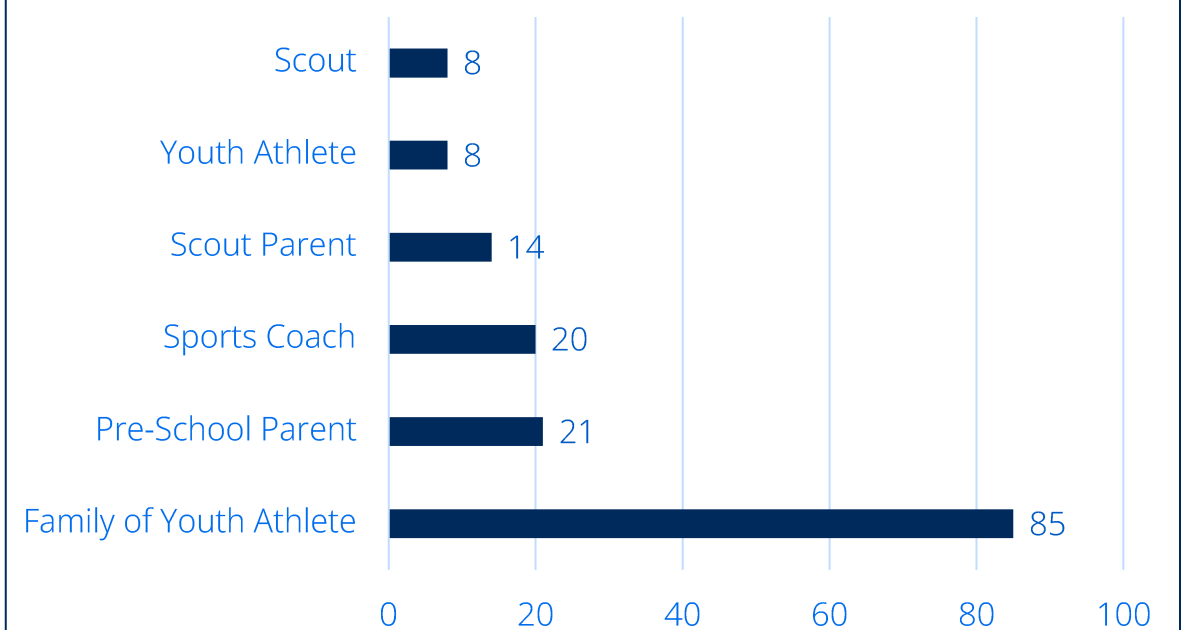
