



VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

POSITION: Kingston Community Advisory Council – Youth Member

DEPARTMENT: Board of County Commissioners

SUMMARY:

Provide a youth perspective as a representative on the Kingston Community Advisory Council. Work with other council members as they review and make recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) on growth management issues such as: land use and zoning, transportation improvements, parks and recreation, design standards, public safety, environmental protection and other related matters. The youth appointment is for a 12-month term, serving from September to August.

DUTIES:

Attend KCAC meetings which take place at least once a month, with the exception of July when the council does not meet. Function as part of a team. Serve as an official communication body between the County Commissioners, Kingston youth and others in North Kitsap.

SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be a resident in the North Kitsap School District and within the boundaries of Kingston-area schools. Must be willing to attend monthly meetings and function as part of an advisory team. Must have the approval of parent or guardian.

RESPONSIBLE TO: Kitsap County Board of Commissioners

TIME COMMITMENT:

Attend monthly meeting on the second Wednesday of the month from 6:30-8 p.m. at the Village Green Community Center. May participate in other KCAC committees.
