## **Note To Voters:**

- This ballot contains all measures and races that will appear on the September 16, 2003, Primary Election ballot. Only the ballot issues that apply to the precinct where you are registered to vote will be counted.
- Regular polling locations will not be open, your ballot must be post-marked no later than September 16, 2003, or taken to a ballot drop-off location on Election Day between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. If you have any questions about voting call the County Elections Division at (360) 337.7128.

**To Vote:** Use a #2 pencil to complete the arrow pointing to your choice. Use one single line to complete the arrow. If voting for a candidate NOT on the ballot, connect the arrow and write in the name of the candidate and the party affiliation in the space provided.



## Marking Your Ballot ...

Voted ballots are read electronically so any extraneous marks on the ballot result in hand processing.

Follow these tips for marking your ballot:

- ➤ Place the ballot on a hard surface, NOT on top of other papers where ink could transfer from the newsprint.
- Mark you choice by drawing **one single line** to complete the arrow.
