Kitsap County, Washington
Primary - August 19, 2008**

To Vote Your Ballot: Connect the arrow by your choice with **one single** dark line like this: 

If you sign or place your name on this ballot, it cannot be counted. To vote for a candidate whose name is **not** on the ballot, write the candidate's name in the space provided.

If you make a mistake: Draw a line through the entire candidate name like this: **John-Dee**
You then have the option of making another choice if you wish.

Note to voters: This ballot contains all measures and races that will appear on the August 19, 2008 Primary Election ballot. Only the ballot issues that apply to the precinct where you are registered to vote will appear on your ballot.

READ: Each candidate for partisan office may state a political party that he or she prefers. A candidate's preference does not imply that the candidate is nominated or endorsed by the party, or that the party approves of or associates with that candidate.
