- Monday thru Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. County Auditor's Office, 619 Division Street, Port Orchard, (also a voting location)

Election Day Only from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.:

- Silverdale Community Center, 9729 Silverdale Way
- Bremerton – Kitsap Regional Library, 1301 Sylvan Way
