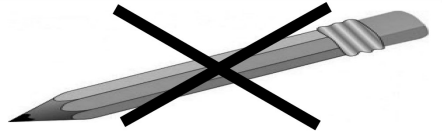

Use dark blue or black ink to fill in the box to the left of your choice.

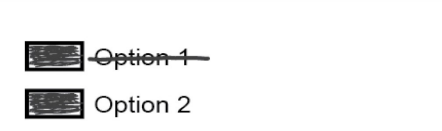


Mark **one** choice for a contest. If you mark more than one choice, no votes will be counted for that contest.

No. 8201

The legislature has proposed a constitutional amendment on allowing money in Washington's long-term care fund to be invested. This amendment would allow the state fund dedicated to providing long-term care benefits for eligible seniors and people with disabilities to be invested as authorized by law.

Bainbridge Island School District No. 303 Proposition No. 1 Supplemental Enrichment & Operations Levy

The Board of Directors of Bainbridge Island School District No. 303 adopted Resolution No. 10-24-25, concerning a proposition supporting educational programs not funded by the state. This proposition would authorize the District to supplement an existing enrichment and operations levy by levying the following excess taxes upon all taxable property within the District, to provide support for educational programs and daily operations, including teaching, instructional support, school supplies, athletics and extracurricular activities, operational support and transportation:

Bainbridge Island Fire Department Proposition No. 1 Property Tax Levy Lid Lift for Fire Protection & Emergency Medical Services

To fund fire protection and emergency medical services for six years, this proposition authorizes a levy rate of \$0.72 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for collection in 2026 and sets the limit factor for each subsequent year at 100% plus the annual percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI-W, first-half to first-half), or the statutory limit factor, which ever is greater. The final year's levy amount would be used to compute limitations for subsequent levies.
