Should the successful bidder fail to enter such contract and furnish a "performance bond" meeting necessary requirement within the time of contract signing the bid bond deposit shall be forfeited.

For contracts of <u>one hundred fifty thousand dollars or less</u>, at the option of the contractor the County may, in lieu of the performance bond, retain ten percent (10%) of the contract amount for a period of thirty days after date of final acceptance, or until receipt of all necessary releases from the department of revenue and the department of labor and industries and settlement of any liens.
