Addendum 1 to Request for Proposal 2025-008 is to answer questions received.

1. What is the anticipated volume of work for this project?
 - A) *The anticipated volume of work for this project is based on the total funding available for treatment and control, which is up to \$50,000 annually. The volume of work completed will not exceed the total funding available each year. Expenditures will be tracked based on a negotiated scope of work with tasks, hours, labor costs, materials, and total compensation.*
 - B) *Treatment sites for Public Works Roads include locations of noxious weeds identified and removed on County right of ways. Total funding available for treatment on County right of ways is \$20,000 annually.*
 - C) *Treatment sites for Parks Department include a total area not to exceed ~100 acres in three parks including Coulter Creek Heritage, Port Gamble Forest Heritage, and Newberry Hill Heritage. Total funding available for treatment and control on priority park areas is \$21,000 annually.*
 - D) *Treatment sites for Public Works Stormwater will be minimal. Contractors may be called to provide noxious weed control and treatment as backup for staff.*
2. What are the target species?
 - Any Class A noxious weed on the state and county weed lists
 - Expected species include but are not limited to the following list:
