Addendum 1 for The above referenced Competitive Solicitation addresses questions received.

1. We understand the County and MSFEG have had several years of extensive coordination on this project. Virtually all of the key background and existing conditions information is held by MSFEG on this project. While most of the project reports are publicly available on the PRISM website, there are numerous additional key pieces of information and data that will be needed – hydraulic models, water level data etc. Does the County and MSFEG have a formal data sharing agreement that will be used for this work, or how does the County envision data sharing will be implemented?

There is no formal data sharing agreement in place between the County and MSFEG; however, the two entities have maintained open and ongoing communication over several years regarding the project area. MSFEG holds many of the technical materials and background data developed through their previous efforts, and they recognize that the outcome of this study is critical to advancing their restoration design. As such, they have expressed a strong willingness to share relevant data—including models, monitoring results, and historical documentation—to support the County's work. The County anticipates data sharing will be facilitated through direct coordination, with MSFEG providing requested materials as needed to ensure the study is well-informed and positioned for success.

2. Can the County give any more detail on the ongoing archeological survey mentioned in the RFP (Task 1, page 10), specifically as to the Area of Potential Effect and general scope (i.e. desktop survey, field work etc)?

The County is contracting with Cultural Resource Consultants for this work (appx. August – January) as follows:

Scope:

Task 1 - Develop Area of Potential Effects (APE) Submittal Package:

CRC will coordinate with the County project manager and Ecology cultural resources staff and review data gathered from DAHP and preliminary plans to assist in establishing the project APE as outlined in Section 106 (36 CFR § 800.3) and in accordance with Ecology's requirements.

CRC will provide the pertinent information in an APE Submittal Package that the County and Ecology need to initiate Section 106 consultation with the Washington State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and affected tribes. CRC will participate in one on-site meeting with the County, SHPO, Ecology, and/or affected tribes.

Draft and final APE submittal package, to be provided electronically.
