I talked with the Assistant Fire Marshal (Tina Turner) today about the stamp on permit 23-02002R2 requiring the fire watch to be present while the fire suppression system is not in service. She agreed that if the heat detector is installed during construction and while the outdoor system is out of service, then no fire watch will be required.

Please attach the email conversation between Tina Turner and Michael Cunningham to the 23-02002 permit documents that are on site during the construction. If an inspector comes saying fire watch needs to be in place, provide them the documents and they can contact the Fire Marshals Office.
