# **ASSESSOR'S OFFICE | WORKGROUPS**

**ADMINISTRATION:** Administers property tax exemptions and provides customer assistance; collaborates with taxing districts, calculates levy rates and assesses business personal property using the cost approach. Manages payroll, accounts payable, processing of public records requests, public engagement activities, and compliance with state reporting requirements.

**CADASTRAL:** Manages tax parcel boundary delineation and property records, including subdivision of parcels for new plats, short plats, and split-merge requests. Administers deed transfers, judicial actions, and boundary line adjustments. Maintains manufactured/mobile home data, verifies legal descriptions for all excise tax affidavits and transactions, and updates taxpayer records to reflect name changes.

**COMMERCIAL:** Performs field inspections and valuation of commercial and industrial property countywide, including land, multifamily housing, offices, warehouses, retail businesses, restaurants, and marinas.

**RESIDENTIAL:** Performs field inspections and valuation of residential properties countywide, including land, single family dwellings, and manufactured/mobile homes.




