Description of Proposed Project:

Arts & Humanities Bainbridge (AHB) is excited to present the 2025 Asian Arts & Heritage Festival, a cultural celebration that honors the contributions and rich heritage of Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander (AANHPI) communities in Kitsap County. This month-long festival includes several stand-alone events supported by AHB taking place throughout May, and will culminate in a grand celebration on May 31st, 2025, on Bainbridge Island at the Filipino Community Hall.

The inaugural festival in 2024 was a resounding success, drawing over 3,600 attendees. Building on this momentum, the 2025 festival aims to attract even more visitors by offering an expanded lineup of events that showcase the rich diversity of cultures, languages, and traditions within the AANHPI communities in Kitsap County. Through partnerships with local Indipino, Filipino, and Asian organizations, AHB will ensure the festival continues to authentically represent these communities.

Tourism and Economic Impact

The Asian Arts & Heritage Festival is designed to attract tourists to Kitsap County, offering a variety of engaging, family-friendly events, including art exhibitions, cultural performances, food markets, workshops, and interactive activities. The festival will draw visitors from across the region, including Seattle and surrounding areas, contributing to the local economy through increased spending on accommodations, dining, and shopping.

Marketing and Promotional Plans:

AHB will execute a comprehensive marketing campaign to promote the festival across multiple platforms. This will include social media outreach, email newsletters, partnerships with local and regional tourism boards, and collaborations with festival sponsors such as Philippine Airlines. Targeted advertisements in regional publications and the distribution of promotional materials in key tourist areas will further amplify the festival's reach. The raffle, featuring prizes such as a round-trip ticket to the Philippines, will be a focal point of the promotional efforts to drive engagement and attendance.

Performance Indicators:

Success will be measured through several performance indicators, including:

- Attendance numbers at each event and the final celebration on June 1, with a goal of surpassing the 3,600 attendees from 2024.
- Social media engagement metrics, such as shares, likes, and comments on festival-related posts.
- Raffle ticket sales and the total amount raised for future festivals.
- Surveys and feedback from attendees, vendors, and sponsors to assess satisfaction and areas for improvement.
- Media coverage and regional recognition of the festival as a premier cultural event in Kitsap County.

The Asian Arts & Heritage Festival aims to become an annual event that not only celebrates the AANHPI community but also serves as a key driver of cultural tourism in Kitsap County, enriching the local community while attracting visitors from afar.

History of Organization/Event:

Arts & Humanities Bainbridge (AHB) has a long-standing tradition of fostering cultural enrichment and promoting the arts within the Bainbridge Island community and beyond. Established in 1986 to support local artists and cultural initiatives, AHB has successfully organized various events that not only celebrate the arts but also contribute significantly to local tourism and the economy.

One of AHB's flagship events, the Fall Arts Festival, has been a major success, drawing over 4,000 attendees in 2023. This festival has become a key attraction, bringing together artists, performers, and visitors from across the region, significantly boosting local businesses through increased spending on accommodations, dining, and shopping.

In 2024, AHB introduced the Asian Arts & Heritage Festival, which drew an impressive 3,600 attendees. This event celebrated the rich cultural heritage of Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander communities and was met with enthusiastic participation from both local residents and visitors. The success of this festival demonstrated AHB's ability to create culturally

significant events that resonate with a wide audience, attracting tourists and enhancing the visibility of Bainbridge Island as a cultural destination.

Looking ahead, AHB is organizing the Creative Threads Festival in 2024, which anticipates drawing several thousand attendees. This event will focus on the rich traditions of textile arts, further solidifying Bainbridge Island's reputation as a hub for creative and cultural events.

AHB's strategic focus includes leveraging Lodging Tax Advisory Committee (LTAC) funds to draw attendees from 50-plus miles away, with an emphasis on the "stay and play" approach. By encouraging visitors to stay overnight and explore the island, AHB aims to maximize economic impact, increasing spending at local accommodations, stores, and restaurants. This approach has proven effective in previous events, as seen in the substantial out-of-town attendance and corresponding boost to the local economy.

Through its history of successful events, AHB has consistently demonstrated its ability to create tourism-driven cultural experiences that benefit both the local community and visitors, making Bainbridge Island a must-visit destination for arts and culture.

Scope of Work:

The Asian Arts & Heritage Festival 2025 will be executed through a carefully structured progression of steps to ensure its success and alignment with the goals of promoting cultural tourism and community engagement. The following outlines the key phases of the project:

- Planning and Coordination (September 2024 December 2024)
- Stakeholder Meetings: Begin with meetings involving key stakeholders, including local Indipino, Filipino, and Asian organizations, sponsors, and community leaders, to gather input and establish partnerships.
- Budgeting and Funding: Finalize the budget, secure additional funding through grants and sponsorships, and allocate resources for different aspects of the festival, such as marketing, logistics, and programming.
- Event Permitting and Approvals: Obtain necessary permits and approvals from local authorities for event venues, including parks, public spaces, and streets.
- Program Development (January 2025 March 2025)
- Event Scheduling: Develop a detailed schedule of events, including art exhibitions, performances, workshops, and the final celebration on June 1, 2025.
- Vendor and Performer Recruitment: Identify and recruit food vendors, artists, performers, and cultural groups to participate in the festival. Ensure a diverse representation of the AANHPI communities.

- Marketing Strategy Development: Create a comprehensive marketing plan, including social media campaigns, print advertising, partnerships with tourism boards, and targeted outreach to potential attendees from outside Kitsap County.
- 3. Marketing and Promotion (April 2025 May 2025)
- Launch Marketing Campaign: Roll out the marketing campaign across all platforms, focusing on regional and national audiences. Promote the "stay and play" concept to encourage overnight stays and extended visits.
- Ticket Sales and Raffle Promotion: Begin selling raffle tickets and promoting the grand prize
 to drive engagement and fundraising efforts. Promote the festival through email newsletters,
 social media, and partner channels.
- Community Outreach: Engage with local communities and schools to build excitement and encourage participation in the festival events.
- 4. Event Execution (May 1,2025 May 31, 2025)
- Event Setup: Coordinate logistics for each event, including venue setup, technical requirements, and vendor placement. Ensure that all locations are accessible and ready for participants.
- Volunteer Coordination: Recruit and train volunteers to assist with various aspects of the festival, including event support, crowd management, and information services.
- Festival Activities: Host a series of events throughout May, leading up to the grand celebration on May 31st. Ensure that each event is executed smoothly, with attention to attendee experience and cultural sensitivity.
- Post-Event Evaluation and Reporting (June 2025)
- Data Collection: Collect data on attendance, social media engagement, vendor and attendee feedback, and economic impact (e.g., local spending).
- Post-Event Meetings: Hold debriefing sessions with stakeholders to evaluate the festival's success, gather insights, and discuss improvements for future events.
- Reporting and Documentation: Compile a comprehensive report detailing the festival's
 outcomes, including performance indicators, economic impact, and lessons learned. Submit
 reports to funders, sponsors, and the AHB board.
- Planning for 2026:Begin preliminary planning for the 2026 festival, incorporating feedback and insights from the 2025 event.

This structured approach ensures that the Asian Arts & Heritage Festival 2025 is executed efficiently and effectively, with clear milestones and a focus on delivering a high-quality cultural experience that attracts tourists and enriches the local community.
