Incident and Circumstances:

On August 30, 2017, a BAC Technician was presented an evidentiary complete breath document from Draeger instrument ARHC-0009 In preparation for a trial. The document showed the instrument allowed the start of the breath test before the completion of the required 15 minute observation period. BTP management and all primary technicians were notified of the issue as well as the manufacture, Draeger Safety Diagnostics Inc.

Draeger Safety Diagnostics Inc. began troubleshooting the issue and could not replicate the observation time issue.

On November 11, 2017, the original technician reported two other Draeger instruments that produced complete breath test documents that showed breath tests allowed before the end of the 15 minute observation periods. The technician reported the arresting trooper (operating officer) told film on one of the instances he entered the observation time that matched the current time displayed on the instrument, expecting the countdown timer to be displayed. The instrument allowed data entry to continue as if the 15 minute observation time had elapsed. The Trooper stopped the test and re-entered the observation start time, now different than the time displayed on the instrument and the countdown timer appeared with the correct time remaining.

Immediate Actions Taken:

On Aug 30, 2017, BTP management, all primary BAC technicians, and the manufacture, Dreger Safety Diagnostics Inc. were notified. Archived breath test files from the breath test in questioned were sent to Dreger to assist them in their evaluation of the problem.

Dreger Safety Diagnostics Inc. began troubleshooting the issue and could not replicate the observation time issue and had no answer to explain the observation time issue.

On Nov 8, 2017, Dreger Safety Diagnostics Inc. notified of the finding by the technician. They were able to duplicate the described sequence from the arresting trooper operator. Dreger will make a software fix to correct the observation timer problem. The fix will likely be in a new software update for several other functionality changes requested by WSP.

On Nov 15, 2017, BTP searched the breath test data base and compiled a list of 66 complete breath tests that were allowed prior to completion of the required 15 minute observation period. Notification letters will be sent to all prosecutorial jurisdictions with observation time affected breath tests.

On Nov 15, 2017, all BAC technicians notified to immediately post signs at each Dreger instrument location reminding operators to ensure the completion of the 15 minute observation period prior to the first breath test and a warning of the possibility of the instrument to accept all data and a breath test prior to completion of the 15 minutes.

Preventative Action:

All BAC technicians will be notified to instructl operators during refresher and transition training of the discovered flaw witth the observation timer and to be aware of it until Draeger completes the software fix and all instruments are updated with it..
