- F. Attend public hearings


## A. How do I review the Notice of Application online?

- 1. Search our Online Permit Center (You do not need to login or create an account)
- 2. Enter the application number listed on your postcard




3. Select "Public Notice" icon or find the "Public Notice" Heading

4. Click on the "Notice of Application" link




# B. Review the application files submitted

# **E.** Become an Interested Party

#### What is an interested party?

An interested party is an individual who wants to be notified of decisions made on a specific proposal. You must be an interested party to receive future notifications related to the proposal.

# F. Attend public hearings

#### When is the public hearing?

If a proposal is required to have a public hearing a Notice of Public Hearing will be sent out to interested parties with the scheduled date. Public hearings for the Hearing Examiner are typically the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of every month and start at 9:00am. You can also view the Hearing Examiner schedule and agendas on our <u>website</u>.

Per <u>Kitsap County Code Chapter 21.05</u>, not all proposals are required to have public hearing. If you have been notified of a proposal that does not require a public hearing, you can still provide public comments to the Project Lead for consideration and that may be included in their staff report.

Once a decision is made all interested parties will be notified.
