2025 Results



2025 Disposal Results*

Participation doubled: **289 visits**, up from 141 in 2024

Number of species doubled: **24 different species disposed of**, up from 11 in 2024

Budget of 15,000 reached in early-mid October, resulting in early wrap-up (Oct. 18)

Top 5 Species Reported: 1-Blackberry, 2-Ivy, 3-Scotch broom, 4-Tansy, 5-Holly

Most Active Months: July and August each saw over 100 visits (total)

Most Popular Facility: Silverdale with 98 total visits (34%)

Status Update

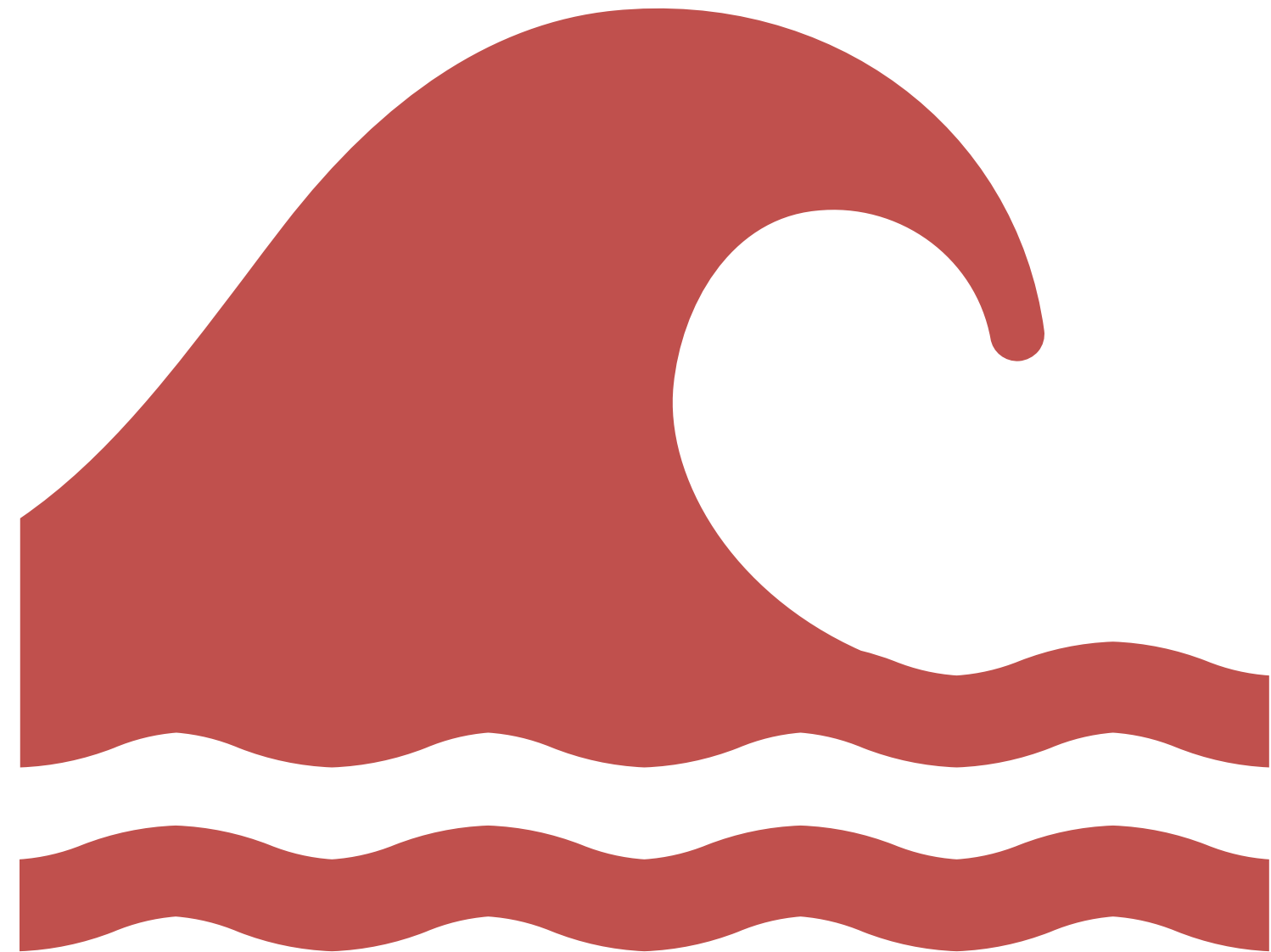


Landowner Assistance Program

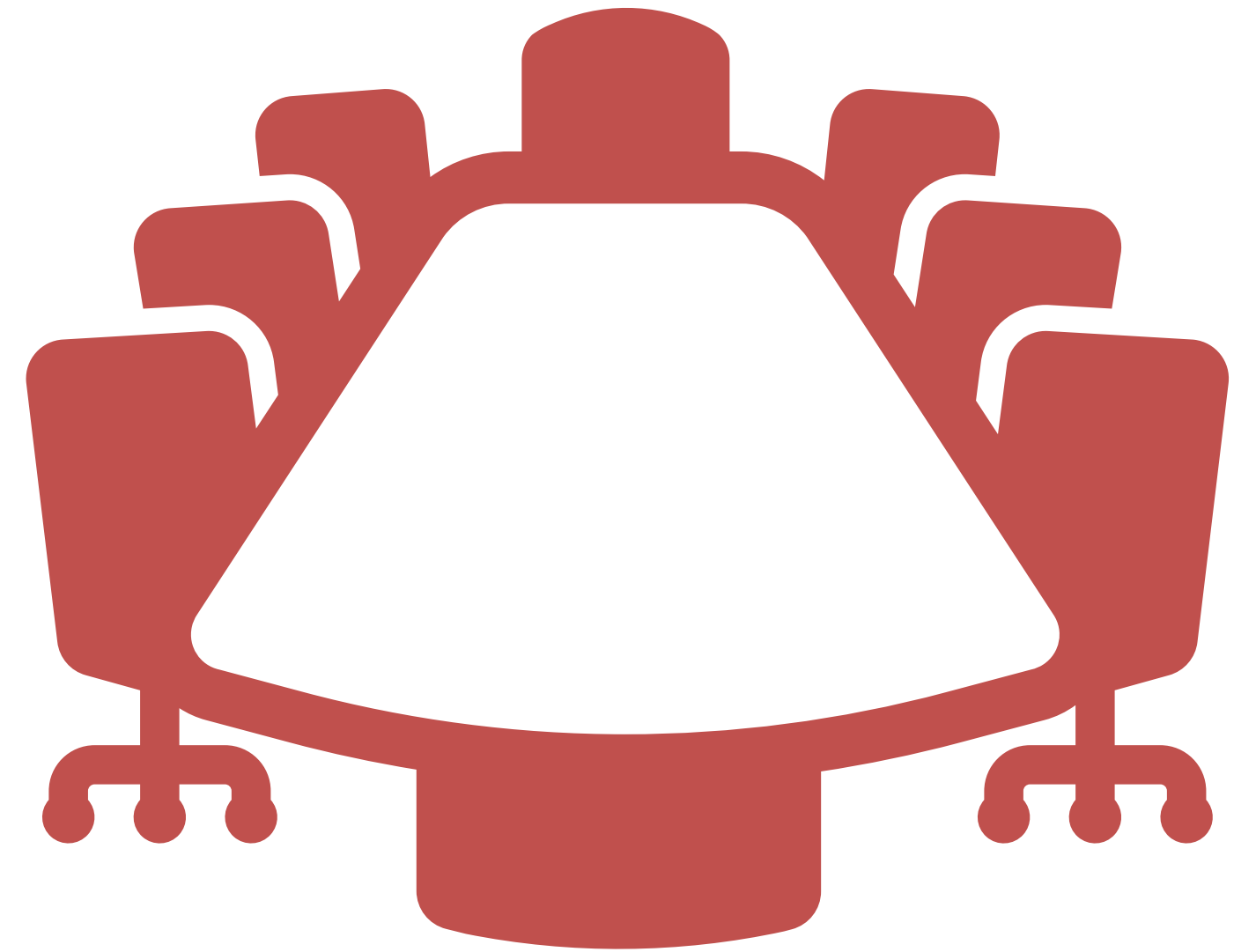


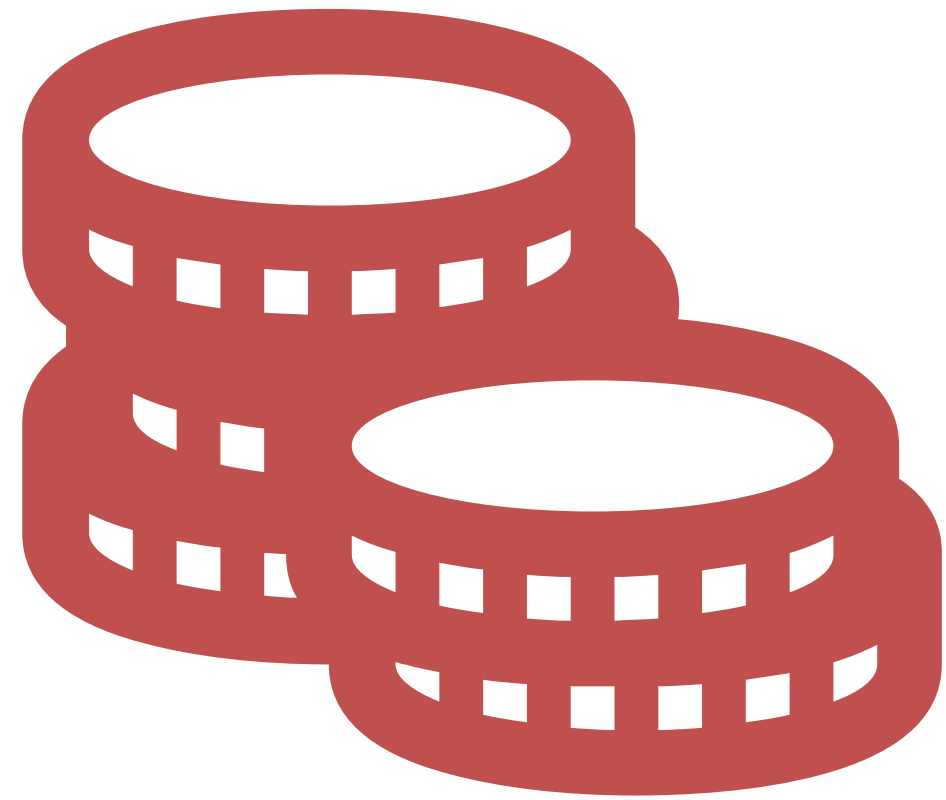
