Action Requested at This Meeting: No action necessary – status update.

Background:

Staff kicked off public outreach for the Bicycle and Electric Vehicle Code Update at the beginning of February with a GovDelivery announcement, social media posts, and personalized letters to a number of groups throughout Kitsap County. They also visited all of the Kitsap County Citizen Advisory Committees throughout January and February. A survey open to the public was a highlight of all of those activities and was featured on the project website as well. That survey has now closed, and we received 195 responses.

Staff have drafted a first version of the new code, and had the workshop group meeting where the draft was refined based on feedback. Staff are briefing the Board of Commissioners on July 6 on the draft code, and will present the draft code at the next Planning Commission meeting.

Scope:

DCD has developed revisions to Kitsap County Code (KCC) Chapter 17.490 Off-Street Parking and Loading to include minimum and incentive-based requirements that encourage new development and redevelopment to install facilities for bicycles and electric vehicles.

The project scope includes:

- Guidance for bicycle parking and electric vehicle charging facilities for new construction and redevelopment, in urban areas, Rural Commercial and Industrial zones and LAMIRDs only.
 - Establish minimum standards and encourage provision of additional facilities with incentives
 - Establish location, dimension, material, design, numeric, and other standards
- Revise/add applicable definitions as needed in 17.110
- Add references between Title 14 and new electric vehicle section
