Background:

On June 22, 2026, the Board of County Commissioner's adopted Boundary Line Adjustment and Property Aggregation Ordinance No. 647-2026. The ordinance introduces new code section 16.64, which establishes review criteria for boundary line adjustments. Many of the revisions made between the initial draft and the final adopted ordinance resulted from the Planning Commission's recommendations and guidance throughout the code development process.

DCD appreciates the Planning Commission's time, effort, and dedication throughout the BLA code development process. The Commission's recommendation to expand outreach to the surveying, real estate, and title communities helped ensure the final ordinance provided property owner protection and review process efficiency.

An organized implementation effort is underway to ensure the necessary administrative procedures, application materials, and educational resources are in place before the ordinance takes effect on January 1, 2027.
