- 18 17.110. --- Adaptive reuse of commercial buildings.
- 19 "Adaptive reuse of commercial buildings" means rehabilitation or renovation of an existing
- 20 commercial building or structure from its original or most recent use to a new use to extend its
- 21 <u>economic life.</u>
- 22 17.110. --- Adult entertainment.
- 23 "Adult entertainment" means any enterprise whose primary emphasis is any activity defined in
- within chapter 10.52 KCC.
- 25 **17.110.045** Adult family home.
- 26 "Adult family home" means a dwelling licensed pursuant to Chapter 70.128 RCW in which a
- 27 person or persons provide personal care, special care, and room and board to a number of
- 28 persons consistent with the state definition.
- 29 17.110.030 Accessory use or structure.
- 30 "Accessory use or structure" means an activity or structure that is commonly associated with
- 31 but subordinate to any principal use or structure.
- 32 17.110. --- Aggregate extractions sites.
- 33 <u>"Aggregate extraction sites" means a use involving on-site extraction of surface or subsurface</u>
- 34 mineral resources. Typical uses are quarries, borrow pits, sand and gravel operation, mining,
- 35 and soil mining. Extraction may require drilling or blasting prior to the processing or rock
- 36 crushing.
- 37 **17.110.** --- Airport.
- 38 "Airport" means any area of land designated, set aside, used, or intended for the takeoff and
- 39 <u>landing of aircrafts. Airports may include support services and accessory uses such as runways,</u>

- 7 17.110.--- Assisted or independent living facility.
- 8 "Assisted or independent living facility" means a facility, other than a clinic, that provides room,
- 9 <u>board, and/or care to dependent children, the elderly, and the physically or mentally</u>
- 10 <u>handicapped. Services in these establishments include, but are not limited to: assistance with</u>
- dressing, grooming, and bathing. Assisted and independent facilities may have a central or

- 21 "Automobile or recreational vehicle repair" means replacement of parts, motor service,

- vehicles, recreational vehicles or trailers.
- 24 <u>17.110. ---</u> <u>Automobile, recreational vehicle or boat sales.</u>
- 25 "Automobile, recreational vehicle or boat sales" means a facility that sells or leases
- 26 <u>automobiles</u>, light trucks, vans, recreational vehicles, or boats, including incidental parking and
- 27 servicing of vehicles for sale or lease.
- 28 _17.110. ---095Automobile service station.
- 29 "Automobile service station" means a building or lot having dispensers and storage tanks where
- 30 fuels or oils for motor vehicles are dispensed, sold, or offered for sale. Service stations may
- 31 include accessory convenience stores and minor automobile services, including car washes.
- 32 17.110.085 Aquaculture practices.
- 33 "Aquaculture practices" means the harvest, culture or farming of cultivated food fish, shellfish

- 35 harvesting of shellfish and hatchery culture, excluding traditional noncommercial shellfish

- 37 17.110.087 Assembly and packaging operations.
- 38 "Assembly and packaging operations" means a facility where premanufactured components are

3 **17.110.090** Automobile repair

- 4 "Automobile repair" means replacement of parts, motor service, rebuilding or reconditioning of
- 5 engines, painting, upholstering, detailing, or cleaning motor vehicles, recreational vehicles or
- 6 trailers.

7 17.110.095 Automobile service station.

- 8 "Automobile service station" means a building or lot having dispensers and storage tanks where

11 **17.110.105** Bed and breakfast house.

24 **17.110.126** Brew pubs.

- 25 "Brew pubs" shall mean a combination of retail, wholesale and manufacturing business that

- 28 "Campground" means a tract of land under single ownership or unified control developed with
- 29 individual sites for rent and containing roads and utilities to accommodate recreational vehicles

- 32 "Car washes" means the use of a site for washing and cleaning of passenger vehicles,

- 35 "Carnival or circus" means a temporary outdoor establishment at which a combination of
- 36 <u>attractions or exhibitions, such as rides, illusions, gaming booths concession stands, and animal</u>
- 37 <u>displays are available for the purpose of amusement and entertainment.</u>

- 1 17.110. --- Case management.
- 2 "Case management" means a process that includes the needs assessment of homeless
- 3 <u>individuals, provides knowledge of resources available to homeless individuals, assists homeless</u>
- 4 individuals create housing plans to help individuals out of homelessness, and has oversight of a
- 5 professional care manager. Volunteers who have completed a case management training
- 6 course through a qualified human services agency may be used to assist with case
- 7 management.
- 8 <u>17.110. ---</u> <u>Cemeteries.</u>
- 9 <u>"Cemeteries" means land and associated buildings and structures used for burial or funerary</u>
- 10 uses. Examples include cemeteries, columbaria and mausoleums.

- "Child care center" means the same as "day-care center."
- 13 **17.110.160** Clinic.
- "Clinic" means a building or portion of a building containing offices for providing nonemergency
- chiropractic, medical, dental, vision, or psychiatric services not involving overnight housing of
- 16 patients.
- 17 **17.110.165 Club**.
- "Club" means a place where an association of persons organized for some common purpose
- meet. This definition excludes places of worship and groups organized primarily for business
- 20 purposes.
- 21 17.110.--- College.
- 22 "College" means a higher education college or university primarily engaged in teaching and
- research, and comprised of multiple educational buildings within a campus setting.
- 24 **17.110.** --- Composting.
- 25 "Composting" means any commercial operation involving the processing of waste in a
- 26 <u>controlled environment to produce a stable product by microbiologically degrading organic</u>
- 27 matter under aerobic conditions and is for use on property other than that on which the
- 28 <u>composting is performed.</u>
- 29 **17.110.177** Conference center.
- 30 "Conference center" means a building or group of buildings with overnight accommodations
- 31 and meeting space, primarily intended for conferences, meetings, and retreats that may
- 32 provide overnight accommodations. Conference centers may include facilities such as dining
- and banquet rooms, recreation rooms and other amenities.
- 34 17.110.180 Congregate care facility.
- 35 "Congregate care facility" means any building in which people live in individual housing units
- 36 which provide for independent living while providing common living areas and limited services
- 37 such as health care, meals and housekeeping.

- 1 17.110.190 Convalescent, nursing or rest home.
- 2 "Convalescent, nursing or rest home" means any building or premises in or on which sick,

- 5 17.110.195 Contractor's storage yard.
- 6 "Contractor's storage yard" means a place where heavy equipment, vehicles, construction

- 8 grading, grubbing, or construction, is stored or accumulated. Sites that involve current
- 9 construction of projects with active permits involving the materials on site shall not be
- 10 considered a contractor's storage yard.
- 11 17.110.196 Cottage housing development.
- "Cottage housing development" means a tract of land under single ownership or unified control
- developed with four or more detached living structures sharing any of the following: common
- 14 kitchen and sanitation facilities, common area/courtyard and/or parking area.
- 15 **17.110.199 Custom art and craft stores.**
- 16 "Custom art and craft stores" shall mean a business in which finished, personal or household
- items are produced and/or sold. Examples include, but are not limited to: pottery and candle
- making; leather work; jewelry making; creation of sculpture or other artwork.
- 19 **17.110.200 Day-care center.**
- 20 "Day-care center" means a facility other than a private residence in which any number of
- 21 children are cared for during some portion of a twenty-four hour period.primary dwelling in
- 22 which seven or more individuals, or a building other than a primary dwelling in which any
- 23 number of individuals, are cared for during some portion of a twenty four hour period.
- 24 17.110.205 Day-care center, home basedfamily.
- 25 "Day-care center, familyhome based" means an owner- or manager-occupied primary dwelling
- and premises in and on which not more than six individuals are cared for during some portion
- of a twenty-four-hour period.
- 28 **17.110.---** Dispatch facility.
- 29 "Dispatch facility" means a privately owned facility for the storage, dispatch, and maintenance
- 30 of vehicles such as ambulances, taxis, or shuttles. A dispatch facility does not include storage
- 31 for ride-share or rental vehicles.
- 32 **17.110.---** Dormitory.
- 33 "Dormitory" means a college or university building that provides boarding school, college, or
- 34 <u>university students with sleeping quarters, common bathrooms, common rooms, and may</u>
- 35 include a dining area and cafeteria.
- 36 **17.110.228 Drinking establishments.**
- 37 "Drinking establishments" means a business primarily engaged in the retail sale of alcoholic

- 18 "Entertainment facility, indoor" means an indoor facility designed and equipped for the

- 29 <u>use includes storage and incidental maintenance, but does not include an automobile rental</u>
- 30 <u>facility.</u>
- 31 17.110.--- Equipment sales, rentals and repair, light.
- 32 "Equipment sales, rentals and repair, light" means an establishment providing the sales, rentals
- and repair of tools, lawn and garden equipment, household equipment, party supplies and
- 34 similar goods and equipment. The use includes storage and incidental maintenance, but does
- 35 <u>not include an automobile rental facility.</u>
- 36 17.110.--- Equipment sales, rentals and repair, recreational.
- 37 <u>"Equipment sales, rentals and repair, recreational" means an establishment providing the sales,</u>
- 38 <u>rental, or repair of recreational equipment. The uses includes associated storage and incidental</u>

- maintenance. Examples include, but are not limited to kayaks, rafts, paddleboards, bikes, 1
- 2 electric bikes and scooters and ATV's.
- 3 17.110.---Espresso stands.
- "Espresso stands" means a retail food business in a freestanding building that sells coffee or 4
- 5 other beverages and premade baked goods from a drive-through or walk-up window for
- 6 consumption off the premises and that provides no indoor or outdoor seating.
- 7 17.110.---**Event facility**
- 8 "Event facility" means a facility or site where special events, such as weddings, retreats, or
- 9 conferences, are conducted in exchange for compensation and that are not part of a larger
- 10 venue, such as a hotel, resort, or conference center.
- 11 17.110.270 Family
- 12 "Family" means two or more persons customarily living together as a single housekeeping unit
- 13 and using common cooking facilities, as distinguished from a group occupying a hotel, club,
- 14 boarding or lodging house, or other group of unrelated individuals group living.
- Family living. **17.110.---**15
- "Dwelling, family living" means the residential occupancy of a structure by a family. Each 16

- pyrotechnic" or "consumer fireworks" or "display fireworks" as set forth in Chapter 70.77 32
- RCW.² 33
- 34 17.110.---Firework, sales.

- "Firework sales" means an establishment that offers for sale or sells fireworks to a consumer or 1

- 3 17.110.272 Fitness center.
- 4 "Fitness center" means a place of business with equipment and facilities for exercising and
- 5 improving physical fitness. Examples include health clubs, boxing gyms and micro-gyms.
- 6 Food and beverage production.
- 7 "Food and beverage production" means an establishment that transforms animal and plant
- 8 products for intermediate or final consumption; or they manufacture beverages. These
- 9 products are typically sold to wholesalers or retailers. Beverage manufacturing includes the
- 10 manufacture of nonalcoholic and fermented and distilled alcoholic beverages.
- 11 17.110.---**Fuel distributors.**
- 12 "Fuel distributors" means a facility for the storage of fuels or other volatile products and for
- 13 their distribution to retail sales facilities or other bulk purchasers, regardless of ownership.
- 14 17.110.--- Fuel or charging station, with convenience store.
- "Fuel or charging station, with convenience store" means a facility that provides gasoline 15
- and/or diesel fuel, electric vehicle charging stations to retail consumers with a facility that sells 16
- convenience goods as a secondary activity. 17
- 18 17.110.--- Fuel or charging station, without convenience store.
- 19 "Fuel or charging station, without convenience store" means a facility that provides gasoline
- 20 and/or electric charging stations to retail consumers.
- **17.110.---** Funeral home. 21
- "Funeral home" means a building or part thereof used for human funeral services. Such 22
- 23 building may contain space and facilities for (a) embalming and the performance of other
- 24 services used in the preparation of the dead for burial; (b) the performance of autopsies and
- 25 related surgical procedures; (c) the storage of caskets, funeral urns, and other related funeral
- supplies; (d) storage of funeral vehicles; and (e) facilities for cremation. 26

- 32 "General retail merchandise stores" means stores that sell a wide variety of grocery and
- 33 nongrocery items, including, but not limited to: fresh foods; packaged foods for preparation
- 34 and consumption in the home; household supplies; consumer electronics; hardware; auto parts
- 35 and accessories; pet supplies; apparel; arts and crafts, and sporting goods.
- 36 17.110.302 General office and management services.

- 1 "General office and management services" means the offices of real estate agencies;
- 2 advertising agencies; mailing services and postal substations; employment agencies; insurance

- 5 and construction firms with no outdoor storage, banking, mortgage and title institutions; and

- by governmental agency to provide one or more governmental services to the public.

- 16 A. A dwelling unit containing up to eight unrelated persons who are mentally or physically
- impaired who are protected under the Fair Housing Act, along with support or supervisory
- 18 <u>personnel or family members who may reside at the facility.</u>
- 19 B. The term mental or physical impairment includes conditions such as blindness, hearing
- 20 <u>impairment, mobility impairment, HIV infection, mental retardation, alcoholism, drug</u>

- 2 "Guest house" means living quarters in an accessory building for the use of the occupant,

- 5 **17.110.330** Heavy equipment.
- 6 "Heavy equipment" means, but shall not be limited to, self-powered, self-propelled or towed

- 30 **17.110.360** Hospital.
- 31 "Hospital" means any institution, place, building, or agency which maintains and operates

- 33 convalescence and also including care during and after pregnancy; or which maintains and
- 34 operates organized facilities for any such purpose, and to which persons may be admitted for

- 1 "Hotel/motel" means a building in which lodging is provided and offered to the public for

- 8 primary purpose of compensation, or where pets are housed for resale, such as pet shops, but
- 9 not including a veterinary hospital where boarding is incidental to treatment.
- 10 **17.110.380** Kennel, hobby.
- 11 "Hobby kennel" means any indoor or outdoor facility where cats and/or dogs are routinely
- 12 housed or maintained by or for any person or entity that is not an animal welfare organization
- and that desires to breed or maintain five or more spayed or neutered adult cats and/or five or
- 14 more spayed or neutered adult dogs at the same location or residence, for primarily
- 15 noncommercial purposes.
- 16 17.110.--- Large transitory accommodations.
- 17 <u>"Indoor transitory accommodations" see 17.505.020 C.</u>
- 18 <u>17.110.---</u> <u>Lumber and bulky building material sales.</u>
- 19 "Lumber and bulky building material sales" means an establishment providing the sale of
- 20 building supplies, construction equipment, or home decorating fixtures and accessories. This
- 21 <u>includes lumber yards.</u>
- 22 **17.110.470** Manufactured home.
- 23 "Manufactured home" means a single-family dwelling constructed after June 15, 1976, and
- 24 built according to the Department of Housing and Urban Development Manufactured Home
- 25 Construction and Safety Standards Act. A manufactured home is built on a permanent chassis.
- 26 17.110.-- Manufactured/mobile/RV/park- model/tiny home parks.
- 27 "Manufactured/mobile/RV/park model/tiny home parks" means a parcel of land which has
- been planned and improved for the placement of manufactured homes, recreational vehicles,
- 29 tiny homes, and/or park models, including hook up facilities, for permanent residential use.
- 30 Accessory uses often include bathing and laundry uses.
- 31 17.110.--- Manufactured home, park models, tiny homes sales.
- 32 "Manufactured home, park models, tiny home sales" means an establishment where
- 33 manufactured homes, park models, and tiny homes are sold and/or stored for the purpose of
- 34 <u>sale directly to the public.</u>
- 35 **17.110.473 Manufacturing and fabrication.**
- 36 "Manufacturing and fabrication" means the transformation of materials or substances into new
- 37 products, including construction and assembling of component parts, and the blending of

- materials such as lubricating oils, plastics, resins or liquors. <u>This includes assembly and packing</u>
 operations as defined in 17.110.087.
- A. Light: Light manufacturing and fabrication is characterized by the use being contained within buildings, and materials or equipment used in production not being stored outside. Light manufacturing and fabrication activities do not generate external emissions such as smoke, odor, noise, vibrations or other nuisances outside the building. This definition may include, but is not limited to, manufacture and fabrication of electronic components, software, office products, furniture, glass products, and other manufacturing and fabrication uses as determined by the reviewing official.
- B. Medium: Medium manufacturing and fabrication is characterized by need for only very limited areas of outdoor storage and may create minor external environmental impacts during the conduct of operations but most impacts are contained on site. This definition may include, but is not limited to, manufacture and fabrication of paints, printing ink, leather goods, and other manufacturing and fabrication uses as determined by the reviewing official.
 - C. Heavy: Heavy manufacturing and fabrication uses are often characterized by the need for large outdoor areas in which to conduct operations, and typically results in environmental impacts beyond their own sites. This definition may include, but is not limited to, manufacture and fabrication of automotive vehicles and their parts, cement, brick, lime, gypsum, asphalt, and other manufacturing and fabrication uses as determined by the reviewing official. This definition excludes manufacture and fabrication of hazardous materials.
 - D. Hazardous: Hazardous manufacturing and fabrication uses are those engaged in the manufacture or fabrication of materials that are flammable, explosive, or present hazards to the public health, safety, and welfare, including all substances and materials defined as hazardous materials, hazardous substances, or hazardous waste.

- 28 "Marijuana" means all parts of the plant Cannabis, whether growing or not, with a THC
- concentration greater than 0.3 percent on a dry weight basis; the seeds thereof; the resin

- 31 mixture, or preparation of the plant, its seeds or resin. The term does not include the mature

- personal or commercial, and generally including goods or services related to boating. Marinas
- 24 <u>also include wet moorage facilities where boat moorage slips may be leased or rented to</u>
- 25 individuals who are not a member owner of an associated residential development. Launching
- 26 <u>facilities may also be provided. Marinas may be open to the general public or restricted on the</u>

- 28 17.110.--- Marina support services.

- 1 17.110.490 Mobile home.
- 2 "Mobile home" means a factory-built single-family dwelling constructed prior to June 15, 1976,
- 3 to standards other than the Department of Housing and Urban Development Manufactured
- 4 Home Construction and Safety Standards Act.
- 5 **17.110.493** Mobile home park.
- 6 "Mobile home park" means a tract of land developed or operated as a unit with individual
- 7 leased sites and facilities to accommodate two or more mobile homes or manufactured homes.
- 8 <u>17.110.---</u> <u>Mobile vendor.</u>
- 9 "Mobile vendor" means a person, corporation, company, or business that sells or offers for sale
- wares, merchandise, beverages or food using a vehicle capable of movement. Examples
- include, but are not limited to food trucks or mobile retail sales.
- 12 17.110.504 Movie/performance theater.
- 13 "Movie/performance theater" means a facility for showing films and performance art, including

- 15 **17.110.250 Dwelling, mMultiple-family dwelling.**
- 16 "Dwelling, mMultiple-family dwelling" means a building or portion thereof containing three two

- 19 17.110.512 Nonmotorized recreational rentals.
- 20 "Nonmotorized recreational rentals" means any form of transportation that provides personal
- or goods mobility by methods other than a motor.
- 22 **17.110.520** Nursery, retail.
- 23 "Nursery, retail" means an establishment where trees, shrubs and other plant materials are
- 24 grown, propagated and/or stored for purpose of sale directly to the public.
- 25 **17.110.525** Nursery, wholesale.
- 26 "Nursery, wholesale" or "wholesale nursery" means an establishment where trees, shrubs or
- other plants are propagated on the property and/or continuously grown to a larger size for a

- 29 regular basis. Temporary outdoor stands for the periodic and occasional sale of plants which

- 35 "Off-street parking facilities" means a site or portion of a site, devoted to the off-street parking
- of vehicles, including parking spaces, aisles, access drives, and landscaped areas.

- 1 17.110.--- Off-street parking facilities, structured.
- 2 "Structured parking facilities" means a structure or portion thereof composed of one or more
- 3 <u>levels or floors used exclusively for the parking or storage of motor vehicles. A parking structure</u>
- 4 may be below grade, at grade, or above grade with those levels being either open or enclosed.
- 5 **17.110.535** Open space.
- 6 "Open space" shall mean land used for outdoor active or passive recreational purposes or for
- 7 critical area or resource land protection, including structures incidental to these open space
- 8 uses, including associated critical area buffers, but excluding land occupied by dwellings or hard

- 7 **17.110.591** Pharmacies.
- 8 "Pharmacies" shall mean businesses primarily engaged in the sale of prescription and over-the-
- 9 counter drugs, vitamins, first-aid supplies, and other health-related products. Pharmacies that
- also sell a wide variety of other types of merchandise, such as beauty products, camera
- 11 equipment, small consumer electronics, gift wares, housewares, and/or cleaning supplies are
- 12 considered "general merchandise stores."
- 13 **17.110.600** Places of worship.
- 14 "Places of worship" means a permanently located building primarily used for religious worship.
- 15 <u>17.110.630</u> Private airport or heliport.
- 16 "Private airport or heliport" means any runway, landing area or other facility designed and used
- by individual property owners for private aircraft for the purposes of landing and taking off,
- including associated facilities, such as hangars and taxiways.
- 19 **17.110.640** Public facilities.
- 20 "Public facilities" means streets, roads, highways, sidewalks, street and road lighting systems,
- 21 traffic signals, domestic water systems, stormwater infrastructure, and sanitary sewer systems,
- 22 waste handling facilities designated as public facilities in the comprehensive solid waste
- 23 management plan, parks and recreational facilities, schools, public works storage facilities and
- road sheds, and utilities such as power, phone and cable television.
- 25 **17.110.644** Race track, major.
- 26 "Race track, major" means a public or private facility developed for the purpose of operating
- 27 and/or competitive racing of automobiles, motorcycles or similar vehicles. The facility may
- 28 allow for up to six thousand spectators and may contain an oval, drag strip, road track and/or
- 29 other course. Accessory uses may include the sale of concessions and souvenirs, a recreational
- 30 vehicle camping park, community events and/or vehicle safety training.

- 32 "Race track, minor" means a public or privately owned course designed for the operating

- and board, and medical care. Such a facility serves at least five, but not more than twenty-five

- 26 17.110.--- Research laboratory.
- 27 "Research laboratory" means a building or group of buildings used for scientific research,
- 28 investigation, testing, or experimentation, but not facilities for the manufacture or sale of
- 29 products, except as incidental to the main purpose of the laboratory.
- 30 **17.110.---** Resort.
- 31 "Resort" means a group of buildings under unified ownership or control that provide overnight

- 35 17.110.662 Restaurant, without drive-thru service.

- 17 Montessori schools are included, as are satellite buildings of higher education colleges.
- 18 17.110.--- Secure community transition facility.
- 19 "Secure community transition facility" means a secure facility that provides supervision,
- 20 <u>security, ensures the provision of sex offender treatment services, and are established pursuant</u>
- 21 to RCW 71.09.
- 22 <u>17.110.---</u> <u>Shared work/maker space.</u>
- 23 "Shared work/maker space" means a facility offering work related amenities to be used by
- 24 individuals or groups in exchange for compensation. Amenities include, but are not limited to,
- 25 meeting rooms, private offices, high speed internet, artist studios, craft spaces, woodworking

- 34 space and under controlled feeding, sanitation, harvesting, or processing procedures.
- 35 <u>17.110.---</u> <u>Shelter.</u>
- 36 "Shelter" means a residential facility serving as a center to receive, provide and house persons
- 37 who need shelter. The shelter may allow partners, dependents, pets, and/or possessions. The
- 38 <u>facility may provide on-site services.</u>

- 1 17.110.--- Shooting/gun facility, indoor.9
- 2 "Shooting/gun facility, indoor" means an indoor facility designated for the discharge of firearms
- 3 for individuals wishing to practice, improve upon or compete as to their shooting skills. The
- 4 facility may have a site with one or more shooting ranges, but does not include residential
- 5 property.
- 6 17.110.--- Shooting/gun facility, outdoor. 10
- 7 "Shooting/gun facility, outdoor" means an outdoor facility designated for the discharge of
- 8 firearms for individuals wishing to practice, improve upon or compete as to their shooting skills.
- 9 The facility may have a site with one or more shooting ranges, but does not include residential
- 10 property.
- 11 <u>17.110.---</u> Single-family transitory accommodations.
- 12 "Single-family transitory accommodations" see 17.505.020 A.
- 13 <u>17.110.--- Small transitory accommodations.</u>
- 14 <u>"Small transitory accommodations"</u> see 17.505.020 B.
- 15 **17.110.240 Dwelling, sSingle-family attached dwelling.**
- 16 "Dwelling, single Single -family attached dwelling" or "attached single-family dwelling" means a
- 17 single dwelling unit designed for occupancy by not more than one family and separated from
- 18 adjacent units by one or more common vertical walls. where each dwelling includes adjacent
- 19 dwelling-specific yard area within its ownership.
- 20 17.110.242 Dwelling, sSingle-family detached dwelling.
- 21 "Dwelling, sSingle-family detached dwelling" or "detached single-family dwelling" means a
- 22 single dwelling unit designed for occupancy by not more than one family that is physically
- 23 separated from any other dwelling unit.
- 24 17.110.--- Slaughterhouse or animal processing.
- 25 "Slaughterhouse or animal processing" means a building or facility used for the slaughtering of
- 26 <u>animals and the processing and storage of animal products and waste that results from a</u>
- 27 <u>slaughtering process.</u>
- 28 **17.110.---** Special care residence.¹¹
- 29 "Special care residence" means a manufactured or mobile home used by a family member in
- 30 need of special, frequent and routine care and assistance by reason of advanced age or ill

- 32 17.110.688 Storage, hazardous materials.
- 33 "Storage, hazardous materials" means the storage of materials produced on site or brought

- 7 equipment storage, and hazardous materials storage.
- 8 17.110.690 Storage, vehicles and equipment.
- 9 "Storage, vehicles and equipment" means an indoor or outdoor area for parking or holding of
- 10 motor vehicles and boats or wheeled equipment for more than seventy-two hours. This
- definition excludes automotive sales and rentals, <u>automobile or recreational vehicle</u>
- 12 repairautomotive service and repair shops, equipment sales, rentals, and repair, and auto
- 13 wrecking yards.
- 14 **17.110.691** Storage, indoor.
- 15 "Storage, indoor" means a building or group of buildings consisting of self-contained units
- 16 <u>leased to individuals, organizations or businesses for self storage of personal property of goods</u>

- 18 vehicle storage. means storage of goods and/or materials located within a building. The

- 22 "Storage, outdoor" means outdoor storage of products, supplies, and equipment. The definition

- 26 "Storage container" means any repository twenty-five feet or less in length commonly used for

- office for supervision on a construction site, a temporary on-site real estate office, temporary
- business office in advance of a permanent facility construction, or a dwelling unit temporarily
- 35 used for display purposes as an example for dwelling units available for sale or rental in a
- 36 particular subdivision or residential development.
- 37 <u>17.110.---</u> <u>Top soil production.</u>

- 1 "Top soil production" means any commercial operation involving the production and sale of top
- 2 soil in any form for use on property other than that on which the operation is located.
- 3 <u>17.110.---</u> Transitory accommodations.
- 4 "Transitory accommodations" means shelters, as defined in Chapter 17.505, that are not
- 5 permanently attached to the ground, may easily be erected and dismantled or moved, and are
- 6 <u>intended for temporary occupancy. Transitory accommodations also includes all other facilities</u>
- 7 specifically identified in chapter 17.505 'Transitory Accommodations'. 12
- 8 17.110.--- Transportation terminals, marine.
- 9 <u>"Transportation terminals, marine" means a building, structure, or area that primarily supports</u>
- ancillary facilities for water-borne transportation (e.g. commuter ferries, water taxies,
- 11 <u>hovercraft</u>) or short-term excursions (e.g. charter boats, mini-cruises, sight-seeing, gambling,
- dining, and entertainment on the water) including but not limited to: passenger terminals and
- 13 berthing areas, storage, employee or passenger parking, administrative functions, ship servicing
- 14 <u>area, layover berths, fueling stations, and other boat or passenger services.</u>
- 15 <u>17.110.---</u> Transportation terminals, non-marine.
- 16 "Transportation terminals, non-marine" means a building, structure, or area designed for
- 17 <u>persons changing transportation modes. This definition excludes marine transportation</u>
- 18 <u>terminals.</u>
- 19 17.110.--- Transshipment facilities.
- 20 <u>"Transshipment facilities" means a facility designed to transfer cargo from one ship or other</u>
- 21 form of transport to another. Examples include, but are not limited to: docks, wharves, marine
- 22 <u>rails, cranes, and barge facilities.</u>
- 23 **17.110.---** Useable marijuana
- 24 "Useable marijuana" means dried marijuana flowers; it does not include marijuana-infused
- 25 products. Where this definition conflicts with RCW 69.50.101, as now or hereafter amended,
- 26 that in state law shall govern. 13
- 27 **17.110.---** Vacation rental.
- 28 "Short-term vacation rental" means a dwelling unit used by any person or group of persons,
- 29 other than the owner, which is occupied through payment to the owner for a period of less
- 30 than thirty calendar days, counting portions of days as full days.
- 31 **17.110.740** Veterinary clinic.
- "Veterinary clinic" means the same as "animal hospital."
- 33 **17.110.---** Vocational school.

- 1 "Vocational school" means an institution providing instruction and training in a specific service:
- 2 art, dance, driving, and music. Includes vocation or trade such as business, real estate, travel,
- 3 <u>auto machinery repair, welding, and skill center.</u>
- 4 17.110.--- Warehousing and distribution.
- 5 "Warehousing and distribution" means a facility where goods are received and/or stored for
- 6 delivery to other firms or the final customer.
- 7 17.110.--- Wetland mitigation bank.
- 8 <u>"Wetland mitigation bank" means a site where wetlands are restored, created, enhanced or</u>
- 9 preserved exclusively for the purpose of compensatory mitigation in advance of authorized
- 10 <u>impacts to similar resources.</u>
- 11 **17.110.---** Wildlife shelter.
- "Wildlife shelter" means a place where non-domesticated animals are given medical or surgical
- 13 treatment and are cared for during the time of such treatment and until they are ready for
- 14 release back into the wild. A wildlife shelter generally includes a combination of structures and
- 15 outdoor enclosures.
- 16 17.110.770 Wireless communication facility.
- "Wireless communication facility" means the antennas, nodes, control boxes, towers, poles,
- 18 conduits, ducts, pedestals, electronics and other related equipment used for the purpose of
- 19 transmitting, receiving, distributing, providing, or accommodating wireless communications
- 20 services.

- 21 A. A "small wireless facility" means a facility that meets each of the following conditions:
- 22 1. The facility:
 - a. Is mounted on a structure fifty feet or less in height, with the height including any antennas; or
 - b. Is mounted on a structure no more than ten percent taller than other adjacent structures; or
 - c. Does not extend an existing structure on which it is to be located to a height of more than fifty feet or by more than ten percent, whichever is greater;
 - 2. Each antenna associated with the facility, excluding associated antenna equipment, is no more than three cubic feet in volume; and
 - 3. All other wireless equipment associated with the structure, including the wireless equipment associated with the antenna and any pre-existing associated equipment on the structure, is no more than twenty-eight cubic feet in volume; and
 - 4. The facility is not required to be registered with the FCC under 47 CFR Part 17; and
- 5. The facility does not result in human exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the applicable FCC safety standards in 47 CFR 1.1307(b).
- B. A "nontower wireless facility" means a facility that is not a small wireless facility and does not involve, as part of the initial installation or construction, a wireless support structure.
- 39 The term includes antennas, data collection units, and related equipment, but shall not
- 40 include any wireless support structure. Except as allowed for small wireless facilities, the

- need to construct a wireless support structure will transform the nontower facility into a tower-based facility.
- C. A "tower-based wireless facility" means a facility installed or constructed with a tower as
 defined in Section 17.110.721. Unless a DAS hub facility meets the definition of a small
 wireless facility, the DAS hub shall be considered a tower-based facility.
- 6 **17.110.783** Wrecking yard.
- 7 "Wrecking yard" means a place where damaged, inoperable or obsolete machinery such as
- 8 cars, trucks and trailers, or parts thereof, are stored, bought, sold, accumulated, exchanged,
- 9 disassembled or handled.
