DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of Proposal: A proposed amendment for producing an Affordable Housing Inventory and Transportation Analysis Report and plan to assist decision makers, staff, and community stakeholders in determining the scope of the need for housing that is affordable for low-income households. This includes identifying potential tools to address the need, and to increase understanding of how the current transportation system aligns with existing affordable housing. This effort is anticipated to be modeled on a similar report produced in 2017 for Skagit County by Eco Northwest. This is a County-wide incorporated and unincorporated effort. The Kitsap County Board of Commissioners must adopt this by Ordinance which is planned for adoption in December of 2018.
