


Identify geographical areas for KNRAMP to focus on & restoration and preservation scenarios

### Section #2: Condition of Natural Assets Across the County

- Goal: Provide a county-wide snapshot of asset conditions.
- Includes: condition of the three assets across the County (% assets with high and very high LOS; % assets with medium LOS; % assets with low and very low LOS)
- Example Insights:
  - What areas across the county show high and very high vs low and very low LOS?
  - Are there any improving or declining trends that we're noticing?
  - Recent policy achievements or planned efforts, e.g., ongoing efforts to remove fish passage barriers.

# State of the Natural Assets Report

## Outline

### Section #3: Key Findings by Asset Type

- Goal: Break down findings for streams, forests, and shorelines.
- Includes: LOS for each asset, attribute-level insights.
- Example Insights:
  - are there specific attributes that drive the LOS of assets in certain areas?
  - What proportion of streams meet clean water standards?
  - What percentage of streams exceed temperature criteria?
  - Number of barriers or percent of stream network with unrestricted fish access.

### Section #4: KNRAMP Focus Areas and Actions

- Goal: Highlight KNRAMP priority watersheds and planned actions.
- Includes:
  - Descriptions of selected areas: function, challenges, restoration, and protection goals.
  - Summary table with actions, goals, and expected improvement

Action	Asset & Attribute	Goals	Expected improvement
Addressing fish passage barriers - culvert replacements	Stream connectivity (fish passage)	Restore fish access to upstream habitat	[#] miles of stream reopened; improved aquatic habitat; better fish populations
