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Title 17 (Zoning) Edits - Comment Period Open

In response to recent data center permitting activity and development occurring in other jurisdictions and around the County, the County has identified a need to further clarify the definitions of "Research laboratories" ([KCC 17.110.658](#)) and "Warehousing and distribution" ([KCC 17.110.743](#)).

There will be a Public Hearing with the Planning Commission for proposed edits on Tuesday, July 21, at 5:30 PM in the Commissioners Chambers located on the third floor of the DCD Administration Building.
