RE: Amendment to Article III, Insurance - Section A, Health and Welfare Benefits

The parties, Kitsap County ("County") and Kitsap County Corrections Officers' Guild ("Guild"), having bargained in good faith, mutually agree to changes in their Collective Bargaining Agreement, KC-165-24 (hereinafter CBA), as follows:

1. The parties' CBA is amended by <u>underline</u>, indicating new matter, and <u>strike-through</u>, indicating deleted matter.

ARTICLE III - INSURANCE

SECTION A - HEALTH AND WELFARE BENEFITS

The County's contributions towards medical, dental and life insurance coverage for regular employees shall be as follows:

- 1. The County's plan offerings and contributions towards medical, dental and life insurance will be as follows:
 - a. **Medical Insurance Coverage**: The 2023-2024 medical plans will be as follows:
 - (1) Kaiser Classic Plan
 - (2) Kaiser Value Plan
 - (3) Kaiser HDHP/HSA 1500 Plan
 - (4) Aetna Classic Plan
 - (5) Aetna Value Plan
 - (6) Aetna HDHP/HSA 1500 Plan

2025

The County agrees to offer Guild members the LEOFF Trust Plan F for medical coverage beginning January 1, 2025, instead of all other plans except the County will continue to offer the Kaiser ClassicHMO Prime Plan (formerly Kaiser Classic) and the Kaiser HMO HDHP/HSA 1500 Plan. The HMO Prime Kaiser Classic Plan and HMO Kaiser HDHP/HSA Plans will continue to be offered unless unfeasible due to low enrollment or other eligibility criteria are no longer met, in which case affected Guild members will be enrolled in the LEOFF Trust Plan F. If the Guild ceases to meet LEOFF Trust Plan F eligibility requirements at any time, all Guild members will be enrolled in the HMO Prime Kaiser Classic Plan.

- b. Medical Insurance Contributions:
 - (1) Regular full-time employees: for regular employees with an established and approved FTE (Full Time Equivalent) of .75 and above
 - i. 2023-2025: effective with the January 2024 premiums, employee contribution rates to County Plans will increase at all tiers by 15%.

Effective January 1, 2025, employee contribution rates to the <u>HMO Prime Kaiser Classic</u> Plan and <u>HMO Kaiser HDP/HSA Plan shall increase at all tiers by 5% each year.</u>

The County will pay 97% of the premium for the employee-only tier and 90% of the premium for all other tiers on the LEOFF Trust Plan F. Employees will pay the remaining premium amount by payroll deduction.

Employees may not enroll twice, both as an employee and a dependent, if eligible to do so

- 3. Except as expressly provided in this Contract Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the parties' original Contract, and subsequent amendments, addenda or modifications
- 4. Except as expressly provided herein, this Amendment shall be effective January 1, 2025.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is by and between Kitsap County ("County") and Kitsap County Corrections Officer's Guild ("Guild"). The parties mutually agree as follows:

Background

The parties executed Collective Bargaining Agreement KC-165-24 (CBA) on February 12, 2024. The County successfully recruited and hired ten (10) lateral corrections officers in 2023. Recently, a discrepancy in the initial step placement of two lateral hires was discovered that created an internal inequity. The parties agree to correct the step placement of two (2) officers to remedy the pay inequity.

Agreement

- 1. The County agrees to correct the step placement of two (2) officers as follows:
 - a. Rothwell, Nicholas will be corrected to current placement of step 8
 - b. Kelly, Sarah will be corrected to current placement of step 8
- 2. The step advancement eligibility date shall not be changed.
- 3. The parties agree that all other rights and contractual requirements in the CBA not addressed in this MOU shall remain in full force and effect.

This MOU shall be effective September 11, 2024.
