This Contract between the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) and the Contractor is hereby amended as follows:

- A. **Exhibit B, Budget,** is revised and replaced by Exhibit B-1, line-item Budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- B. The maximum consideration is decreased by (\$27,255). A reduction of (\$8,917) for T3B, (\$11,342) for T3C1, (\$1,315) for T3C2, (\$161) for T3D, and (\$6,009) for NSIP and an increase of \$489 for T3E, for a new maximum consideration of \$1,083,414.
