

**KC-219-26-B
AMENDMENT TO
CONTRACT FOR HUMAN SERVICES**

This Amendment ("Amendment") to Contract for Human Services is between Kitsap County, a Washington state municipal corporation, with its principal offices at 614 Division Street, Port Orchard, Washington 98366, and **The Salvation Army**, a California Nonprofit Corporation, having its principal office at **30840 Hawthorne Blvd, Rancho Palos Verdes, CA 90275-5301** (the "Contractor").

The parties executed Contract for Human Services KC-219-26 effective January 1, 2026 which was amended by KC-219-26-A ("collectively Contract"), which the parties desire to amend subject to the terms and conditions of this Amendment.

In consideration of the mutual benefits and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 1. Effective Date of Contract. The Contract is extended from July 1, 2026 to December 31, 2026 as identified in the attached Revised Attachment C (Budget Summary).
2. Section 4. Compensation. The total compensation is increased from \$682,389 to \$1,387,201 as identified in the attached Revised Attachment C (Budget Summary).
3. Attachment C: Budget Summary. The Budget Summary shall be amended and replaced in its entirety with the Revised Attachment C (Budget Summary), which is incorporated herein by reference.
4. Effective Date. This Amendment shall be effective on July 1, 2026 ("Effective Date").
5. Insurance. If this Amendment extends the expiration date of the Contract, the Contractor shall provide an updated certificate of insurance evidencing that any required insurance coverages are in effect from the Effective Date through the new Contract expiration date. The Contractor shall submit the certificate of insurance to: Kitsap County Housing and Homelessness Division, 345 6th Street, Suite 400, Bremerton, WA 98337. Upon receipt, the Human Services Department will ensure submission of all insurance documentation to the Risk Management Division, Kitsap County Department of Administrative Services.
6. Precedence. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the provisions of this Amendment and the Contract, including any prior amendments, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
7. Terms Unchanged. Except as expressly provided in this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Contract, including any prior amendments, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
8. Counterparts/Electronic Signature. This Amendment may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Facsimile, email, or other electronically delivered signatures of the parties shall be deemed to constitute original signatures and duplicate originals.

9. Authorizations. The signatories to this Amendment represent that they have been appropriately authorized to enter into this Amendment on behalf of the party for whom they sign, and that no further action or approvals are necessary before execution of this Amendment.

This contract is based on a fixed number of shelter beds being provided for the entirety of the contract period. The contract amount is based on a negotiated bed rate for 91 shelter beds at a 90% utilization rate.

Administration Expenses will be utilizing an Indirect Rate based on the organizations NICRA.
