

**KC-333-25-A
AMENDMENT TO
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT**

This Amendment ("Amendment") to the Professional Services Contract is between Kitsap County, a Washington state municipal corporation, with its principal offices at 614 Division Street, Port Orchard, Washington 98366, and Trillium Employment Services, a Washington State non-profit corporation, with its principal offices at 201 Auburn Way North, Suite B, Auburn, WA 98002.

The parties executed Professional Services Contract KC-333-25 effective July 1, 2025, ("Contract"), which the parties desire to amend, subject to the terms and conditions of the Amendment.

In consideration of the mutual benefits and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Compensation. Section 3.1 (Compensation) of the Contract is amended and restated in its entirety as follows:

The maximum total compensation paid under the Contract by the County shall not exceed \$1,798,439.

2. Effective Date. This Amendment shall be effective on May 1, 2026 ("Effective Date").
3. Ratification. To the extent that any services were provided or payments were made between May 1, 2026, and the date of full execution of this Amendment, the parties hereby ratify and approve such actions, intending them to be governed by the terms and conditions of the Contract as amended herein.
4. Precedence. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the provisions of this Amendment and the Contract, including any prior amendments, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
5. Terms Unchanged. Except as expressly provided in this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Contract, including any prior amendments, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
6. Counterparts/Electronic Signature. This Amendment may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Facsimile, email, or other electronically delivered signatures of the parties shall be deemed to constitute original signatures and duplicate originals.
7. Authorizations. The signatories to this Amendment represent that they have been appropriately authorized to enter into this Amendment on behalf of the party for whom they sign, and that no further action or approvals are necessary before execution of this Amendment.
