**KC-385-25-B
AMENDMENT TO
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT**

This Amendment ("Amendment") to the Professional Services Contract is between Kitsap County, a Washington state municipal corporation, with its principal offices at 614 Division Street, Port Orchard, Washington 98366, on behalf of Olympic Consortium, and Washington State Employment Security Department, a WA Government Agency, with its principal offices at 212 Maple Park Ave SE, Olympia, WA 98501.

The parties executed Professional Services Contract KC-385-25 effective August 25, 2025, which was subsequently amended by KC-385-25-A (collectively "Contract"), which the parties desire to amend subject to the terms and conditions of the Amendment.

In consideration of the mutual benefits and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Compensation. This Amendment decreases the authorized total compensation amount by \$59,416 for a new contract total of \$210,876.
2. Attachment C: Budget Summary & Performance Outcomes. Attachment C replaced in its entirety with the attached revised Attachment C, which is incorporated herein by reference.
3. Effective Date. This Amendment shall be effective upon date of last executed by both parties..
4. Insurance. If this Amendment extends the expiration date of the Contract, the Contractor shall provide an updated certificate of insurance evidencing that any required insurance coverages are in effect from the Effective Date through the new contract expiration date. The Contractor shall submit the certificate of insurance to: Kitsap County Risk Management Division, 614 Division Street, MS-7, Port Orchard, WA 98366.
5. Precedence. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the provisions of this Amendment and the Contract, including any prior amendments, the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
6. Terms Unchanged. Except as expressly provided in this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Contract, including any prior amendments, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
7. Counterparts/Electronic Signature. This Amendment may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Facsimile, email, or other electronically

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delivered signatures of the parties shall be deemed to constitute original signatures and duplicate originals.

8. Authorizations. The signatories to this Amendment represent that they have been appropriately authorized to enter into this Amendment on behalf of the party for whom they sign, and that no further action or approvals are necessary before execution of this Amendment.
