#### PARTNER HIGHLIGHTS:

- In partnership with our coalitions, the OESD is hosting Hidden in Plain Sight. This will be virtual. Flyer has gone out.
- The Coalition leadership model is changing. The group discussed potential hierarchy models for consideration. During the next Coalition meeting, we will be digging deeper to make decisions on the next steps and to select the best model for our coalition and community needs. **Members are highly encouraged to attend the February meeting in person.**
- KCSAPYS shared that a Prevention mural is in the works. Updates include having the potential of 2 school sites and 1 at Kitsap Regional Library. Details will be finalized as soon as possible. More to come.
- KCSAPYS shared that they will be hosting a neighborhood garden program in early 2026. Positions have been filled.

#### MOVING FORWARD – NEXT STEPS:

- Coalition members will be studying coalition models under review. We will be creating a model structured to include components of the Backbone and the Reflective Community models with a focus on the bottom up.
- The group will be prepared to review podcast topics and begin identifying guest speakers.
- Members are encouraged to consider where they fit in prevention, and where they would like to see prevention efforts added or expanded in their agency or organization and prepare to discuss at our next meeting.





