Our services

INFANTS & TODDLERS

Child development services (also known as early support services) are provided to children birth to three years old, who are eligible for services through the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA).

Services typically consist of evaluation, family education and support, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech-language pathology and/or specialized instruction.

ADULT EMPLOYMENT & DAY PROGRAM SERVICES

Employment Services

Over 120 local businesses competitively employ Kitsap residents with developmental disabilities throughout the county.

Transition Services - Job Foundations and School to Work

Transition services prepare young adults exiting the public school system to secure meaningful employment.

Individual Supported Employment (IE)

Services are a part of an individual's pathway to employment and are tailored to individual needs, interests, abilities, and promote career development.

Community Inclusion Activities

Services are individualized and provided in typical integrated community settings.
