Kitsap Homeless Housing Plan Goals:

- 1. Make homelessness rare, working to prevent homelessness whenever possible
- 2. Make homelessness **brief**, respond to the crisis of homelessness immediately to get people inside.
- 3. Make homelessness **one-time**, help people move into appropriate, permanent housing and ensure they can maintain their housing.
- 4. Continuously improve our homeless **response system**, improve capacity, coordination and efficiencies.
- 5. Expand community engagement, develop partnerships with our community.
