Your Roadmap to Court-Mandated Treatment

1. Confirm Eligibility

Review the Kitsap County Therapeutic Court criteria for qualifying offenses and baseline requirements. ***LINK*** Therapeutic Courts

2. Consult Your Attorney

To officially start the referral process, please contact your attorney and request treatment with Kitsap Recovery Center.

- 3. **Have the attorney submit a referral through the court** You'll hear back within 5–7 business days.
- 4. Assessment and placement

You will be contacted for either an in-custody or out of custody assessment appointment. Once assessed and you qualify for treatment you will be recommended for inpatient or outpatient treatment.

5. Begin Your Care Plan

Start Phase I with a tailored regimen of weekly counseling, group work, UA/ETG screening, and collaborative support—earning privileges as you advance.
