## Weekend Family Program Rules and Expectations

- 1. Due to Kitsap County Risk Management policies regarding health and safety, children under 10 years old are not allowed for visiting.
- 2. Dress code includes but is not limited to Health Department standards. Socks must be worn. Shirts/blouses and upper garments must cover the armpits. Private areas of the body must be covered. No revealing clothing or clothes depicting drugs or other negative lifestyle messages. No sunglasses or hats will be worn inside the facility. You may be asked to leave and return more appropriately dressed.
- 3. Disparaging remarks are not acceptable, including those relating to religious preference, race, creed or sexual orientation, etc.
- 4. A brief greeting is appropriate. No physical contact during program.
- 5. Cell phones and pagers are not allowed in the building. If you are on emergency status lease notify staff.
- 6. Limited outside food is allowed, on approval of staff.
- 7. The lawn area behind the basketball court is off limits.
- 8. Visitors may use the restroom across from the reception desk.
- 9. All food and beverages must be left and consumed in dining room area or on the patio. No food is allowed in lecture **areas.**
- 10. All items must be checkedby staff.
- 11. Items may be dropped off for patients at the front desk Monday through Friday 8:30-4:30pm.
- 12. No visitors are allowed in patient rooms under any circumstances.
- 13. Parking of cars is allowed in the parking area directly across the street from KRC.
- 14. Patients and their guests shall always remain within designated areas.
- 15. No pets allowed unless the pet is a documented services animal. Paperwork must be presented, and the service animal must remain in common areas.
- 16. No cameras allowed.
- 17. No tobacco or nicotine delivery products are allowed within the building. No vaping devices or chewing tobacco allowed on the grounds.
- 18. No sharing of homemade food with the community.
- 19. No one will be admitted while under the influence of alcohol and/or other drugs or individuals behaving in a manner that would lead staff to believe the individual(s) are under the influence (including aggressive and disrespectful behaviors).
- 20. No retail food deliveries.
- 21. No power drinks or coffee drinks for the patients.

- 22. No crosstalk or sideline-chatter during the program.
- 23. No profanity.
- 24. All visitors must sign in and out at the TA station whenever entering and/or leaving the facility.
- 25. Should there be an emergency, KRC staff needs to know where everyone is at all times. In the event you are in the restroom listen for announcements and follow staff direction. Should there be a disaster, patient and guest evacuation of the facility will be to the parking lot directly west of KRC.
- 26. We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to the Kitsap Recovery Center Family Program. We invite and encourage you to participate in the treatment process of you loved one. We believe that by doing so you may also begin the healing process from the effects of chemical dependency on the family.
- 27. Visitation for our female patients will be on Saturday and visitation for our male patients will be on Sunday. Visitors are admitted from 12:45pm to 1:00pm. This is the only admission time. No children under the age of 10.
- 28. After lecture, visiting hours are from 3:00pm to 4:00pm. All visitors must attend the lecture time to participate in the visitation hour.
- 29. Our program covers different topics on a four-week rotation. If you have any questions, please contact KRC Monday through Friday between 8:00am and 4:30pm.
