Severe Weather Shelters provide safe and warm beds in Poulsbo, Kingston, Silverdale, and Port Orchard during severe weather events Nov 1 – Mar 31. The program is a partnership between the Kitsap County Department of Human Services, the Kitsap County Department of Emergency Management (KCDEM), and the organizations that host the shelters at their sites. The shelters are managed and staffed by community volunteers.

Shelters may be activated when the National Weather Service forecast projects the weather meets certain criteria • temperatures are expected to be at or below 32 degrees for four or more hours and one or more successive days, and/or • snow accumulation is expected to exceed one inch or more for more than two days and/or • there are two or more successive days of one inch or more of rain. The shelters may also activate when high wind warnings are issued. Whether a shelter activates on a particular night is dependent on if there are enough volunteers to staff that location.
