What's New for 2019

Two-Stage Application Process

- Stage 1: Risk Assessment to evaluate organizational & fiscal capacity, grant contract performance and eligibility.
- Stage 2: Agencies invited to submit project application(s)
- All Applications follow the same schedule

Interviews

- GRC Questions emailed ahead of time
- GRC may decide not to conduct interviews for noncompetitive funds.

What's New for 2019

Policy Changes for all funding

- Public comment periods changed from 30 days to 15 days
- At-Large GRC position added

CDBG/HOME Policy Changes

- Audit requirement
- 2 year awards for Public Service

Stage 1: Risk Assessment

Stage 1 Application - submitted once and includes:

- Agency information (Part 1 in prior years)
- Short summary of proposed projects

Risk Assessment – template included in NOFA

- Staff will review for:
 - Eligibility
 - > Organizational Capacity & Management
 - Financial Stability
 - History of Performance

Stage 1 Application Key Elements

Review of Key Elements

- Agency Budgets & Financial Statements
- Board Minutes & Bylaws
- Org. Chart
- Fiscal & Procurement Policies
 - Policies on file vs. submit
 - Procedures
- Blank/Incomplete forms

Stage 2: Project Application

Applicants will be notified of the results of Stage 1 Review, either:

- Application is moving to Stage 2; or
- Application is disqualified and reason

Stage 2 Application

- Contains project information, very similar to Part 2 from prior years.
- Scored by the GRC and Staff

Stage 2 Application Key Elements

- Project Budgets
- Sources of Financing
- Performance Measurement Worksheet
 - O&M and Homeless projects
- Terms
 - Project vs. Program
 - Unduplicated
 - Glossary under the Resources Tab
- Blank/Incomplete forms
- Follow the instructions when completing narrative questions.

Stage 2: Project Application Types

For Stage 6 there are three application types:

- CHDO Operating
- Economic Development Micro-Enterprise
- Economic Development Capital
- Housing Rental
- Housing Homeownership

FEDERAL FUNDS - US Dept. of HUD funds

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME)

LOCAL FUNDS – WA legislation, document recording surcharge

• Affordable Housing Grant Program (AHGP)

Federal CDBG & HOME Priorities

Kitsap County

- First priority for CDBG & HOME funds will be given to projects for the creation of new rental housing serving households at 50% AMI and below and/or serving special needs populations.
- Second priority will be given to other low income affordable housing projects with highest priority given to projects serving households at 50% AMI and below or special needs populations.
- ED set-aside prioritized for projects which increase economic opportunities for low-income individuals.

City of Bremerton Priority for City HOME funds

 Priority is for projects that increase homeownership opportunities for low to moderate income Bremerton residents through improving and preserving affordable housing in the Bremerton City Limits.

Local – AHGP Affordable Housing Grant Program

- Benefits households below 50% AMI
- Eligible uses
 - Operations and maintenance costs of housing eligible to receive housing trust funds;
 - Acquisition, construction and rehab. of affordable housing;
 - Rental assistance;
 - > Operating costs for emergency shelters.
- Priorities
 - Building operations and maintenance costs and operating costs for emergency shelters.
 - Housing that serves households at or below 30% AMI

Estimated Funds Available

Kitsap County Housing - \$1,538,918.53

- CDBG \$667,873.73
- HOME \$871,044.98
 - \$145,862.69 in HOME is required to be used by a Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO)

City of Bremerton Housing - \$251,449.85 HOME

- \$71,842.81 in HOME is required to be used by a Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO)
- Operations & Maintenance \$300,000 AHGP

Kitsap County Economic Development - \$68,646 CDBG







- Environmental Clearance
- Davis Bacon
- Acquisition and Relocation issues
- Timely expenditure of funds & project completion
- 5 to 20 Year Period of Affordability/Restricted Use
- Match Requirement

Things to be aware of for AHGP O&M Funded Projects:

 Warrant for 25-year Use for Low-Income Housing

Review and Awards Process

Review & Award Process

Stage 1: Risk Assessment & Eligibility Review

- Agency must attend Technical Assistance meeting Make sure you have signed in!
- Application must be submitted by Noon, June 5, 2018

Stage 2: Project Application

 If agency passed Stage 1 – invited to complete Stage 2 Application

Review & Award Process

Stage 2: Eligible Applications Reviewed & Scored by Staff and GRC

- ✓ Organizational & Financial Capacity
- ✓ Program Soundness
- ✓ Community Need & Benefit
- Program Financial Feasibility

Review and Award Process

Interviews

- GRC questions will be emailed to agency addressed at the interview
- Interviews will be scheduled Oct. 1 Oct. 3
- O&M and ED Microenterprise are 20 minutes; all others are 35 minutes
- You may bring anyone you like, but include those who can best answer questions about the overall agency and the specific project.

Review and Award Process

GRC Recommendations

- GRC discusses projects & recommends project funding on Oct. 4th
- Staff works with GRC to match funding sources to projects based on eligibility
- GRC finalizes funding recommendations
- Funding recommendations are posted Oct. 5th
- GRC recommendations are forwarded to the Kitsap Board of County Commissioners for public hearing and approval.


