Neat not Nasty

ONLY rain down the drain.



Allowing trash or grease to enter the storm system is illegal (*KCC Title 12 and Kitsap Public Health District Regulations 025 and 199-14*).



Basic good housekeeping

- Keeps out rats and other disease carrying animals
- Keeps grease, oil, and food products out of storm drains
- Maintains the appearance and reduces odors at your business

Want to pressure wash your dumpster, parking lot or grease bin? Block the storm drain, suck up the wash water, and dump it in an indoor drain.



If You Spill...it's your responsibility to:

Promptly clean up. If you spill grease, soak it up with kitty litter, sweep it up the same day and dump it in the trash.

Keep a spill kit on hand to deal with spills. Train your employees to use the kit and keep records of employee training

Replace your grease container if it leaks. Assure the covers are tight and leak proof.
