EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER RE COURT OFFICE CLOSURE

PURSUANT TO order No. 25700-B-602 of the Supreme Court of Washington and he current COVID-19 pandemic, this Court finds that a member of the Court was positively diagnosed with COVID-19 and may have had close contact with other Court employees, exposing them to COVID-19. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Superior Court of the State of Washington for Kitsap County shall close its offices in the main County Courthouse building, effective Wednesday, March 18, 2020 through Friday, March 20, 2020, so that the Superior Court office and work spaces may be thoroughly cleaned before employees, judges, attorneys and litigants return.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all previously issued Emergency Administrative Orders (2020-1, 2020-2, and 2020-3) remain in effect.
