Professional Beginnings: I was admitted to the Washington State Bar on July 12, 1993, and began the practice of law by researching issues for other attorneys. Bonner Law Office opened on February 1<sup>st</sup>, 1995.

Training: I completed Court Visitor Training in King County every year from 2014 through 2023 (2023 through Zoom). The 2023 Court Visitor Recertification was held on January 27, 2023. Over the years I have received extensive continuing legal education.
