I served as an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) for almost seven years, adjudicating cases related to public benefit applications, DDA services and eligibility, Adult Protective Services and Child Protective Services founded findings, and special education due process hearings involving children with disabilities. Since 2024, I have worked in private practice representing parents and children with disabilities in civil rights matters and special education due process hearings. I am familiar with guardianship law and represent many parents who serve as guardians for their adult disabled children.

I have also served as a suitable representative for appellants in OAH matters who require assistance understanding the administrative appeals process.

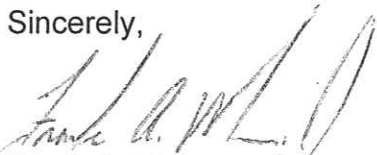
