Deposit shall be paid upon appointment unless there is a written agreement otherwise.

A second deposit of \$1,500.00 for each day of anticipated attendance at trial shall be paid at least 30 days before the scheduled first day of trial.

This is a paperless office to the extent possible. All documents including invoices will be transmitted electronically. Monthly invoices shall be sent to all parties. Invoices shall reflect the total amount billed and/or owed, **not** the respective share of the parties. Should the billed time exceed the deposit during the initial investigation and report finalization, the existing balance should be paid monthly as invoiced. If the parties do not pay the invoice, I will file a motion to authorize additional fees. If the parties do not pay the fees, I will stop working on the case.
