

## WRIT OF RESTITUTION/EJECTMENT - DOCUMENTS NEEDED

- 1. Three (3) conformed copies of the original Writ of Restitution.
- 2. Copy of the Order to Issue the Writ (provided copy <u>must</u> be signed by Judge/Commissioner).
- 3. Tenant Information Sheet.
- Request for Storage of Personal Property form (Required for Writ of Restitutions) RCW 59.18.312 (6). To get the form go to website: LegalWA.org, Revised Code of Washington, RCW 59.18.312
- 5. Advance Fee deposit of \$200.00, payable to the Kitsap County Sheriff's Office. (Could be additional charges billed after completion)
- 6. Sheriff's Indemnity Bond with Power of Attorney (POA) document (for representative signing on behalf of insurance company) for evictions involving the following:
  - ➤ Bond for **foreclosure** \$25,000.00.
  - ➤ Bond for **recreational vehicles** will be twice the value of the personal property with a minimum amount \$25,000.00.
  - ➤ Bond for **commercial property** will be twice the value of the personal property with a minimum amount of \$25,000.00.

## Note:

If the landlord knows that the tenant is a person with a disability as defined by RCW 49.60.040 and the disability impairs or prevents the tenant or the tenant's representative from making a written request for storage, it must be presumed that the tenant has requested the storage of the property as provided in this section unless the tenant objects in writing. RCW 59.18.312(1)

A "Disability" means the presence of a sensory, mental, or physical impairment that: (a) Is medically cognizable or diagnosable; or (b) Exists as a record or history; or (c) Is perceived to exist whether it exists in fact. A disability exists whether it is temporary or permanent, common, or uncommon, mitigated, or unmitigated, or whether or not it limits the ability to work generally or work at a particular job or whether or not it limits any other activity within the scope of chapter 49.60 RCW.
