### Community Notification: Level III Sex Offender

**PORT ORCHARD, Wash.** -- The Kitsap County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.550, and a Washington State Supreme Court decision in State vs. Ward, regarding public notification of the anticipated residency of a convicted sexual offender.

"The person named in this advisory has been convicted of a criminal offense that requires registration with the sheriff's office in the county of residence," said Sheriff Gary Simpson. "Further, his previous criminal history places him in a classification level that reflects the *potential* to re-offend."

**Name:** Elmer Todd Gillis, white male, age 53.

**Residence location:** Mr. Gillis soon will be discharged from the Washington State Special Commitment Center on McNeil Island. He has listed a house in the 17000 block of Viking Way NW, Poulsbo, in Kitsap County, as his place of residence.

**A community notification meeting concerning Mr. Gillis will be held at 6:30 p.m., Monday, Oct. 21 in the Poulsbo City Council Chambers, 200 Moe Street NE, Poulsbo 98370.**

**Elmer Todd Gillis**

**Criminal history:** Elmer Todd Gillis has been convicted of various sexual offenses starting when he was age 18: indecent liberties – 1984; rape, 2<sup>nd</sup> degree – 1990; assault, 4<sup>th</sup> degree – 1993, and assault, 2<sup>nd</sup> degree with sexual motivation – 1993.

Mr. Gillis has been convicted of additional crimes, including: trespassing, driving under the influence and domestic violence simple assault.

While incarcerated he received multiple behavioral infractions for frottage of female hospital employees.

Mr. Gillis is returning to the Viking Way NW residence as he resided there previously. This most recent incarceration was as a result of Mr. Gillis being disrespectful to household staff.

**Additional information:** As of Oct. 14, there are 22,412 sex offenders who have registered as required and are living in Washington state. Of this number, 822 are registered with Kitsap County Sheriff's Office.

Elmer Todd Gillis has served the sentences imposed on him by the courts. He has advised the sheriff's office that he will be living within Kitsap County. This person is not wanted by law enforcement at this time. This notification is not intended to increase fear. Rather, an informed public is a safer public.

The sheriff's office has no legal authority to direct where registered sex offenders may or may not reside. Unless court-ordered restrictions exist, registered sex offenders are constitutionally free to live wherever they choose. Passage of legislation entitled the "Community Protection Act of 1990," mandates sex offender registration which, in turn, has provided civil authorities the means to monitor where sex offenders reside.

Abuse of information provided through the sex offender notification process, to intimidate, harass or threaten registered offenders, will result in an investigation and the filing of criminal charges against the perpetrators.

**Neighborhood Watch:** The sheriff's community resource officer, Deputy Schon Montague, is available to assist communities in establishing block or neighborhood watch programs and to provide the public with information on personal safety.
