#### TAX TITLE SALES

Parcels that have been offered for auction at tax foreclosure sales, but not bid on, are deeded to the county. These parcels are called "Tax-Title". They may be purchased from the county if approved by the Board of County Commissioners. Tax title properties are subject to the same risks as tax foreclosure properties.

Purchasing tax-title property is done through public auction, or in some cases, by private negotiation without a call for bids per RCW 36.35.150. It can take 6-12 months to complete the following process:

#### Step 1:

The applicant must fill out the attached application and pay a \$500.00 (non-refundable) processing fee.

- The application must include the legal description <u>of the tax title parcel</u>. We cannot provide one for you. It is usually written by a professional surveyor or title company.
- The application must also have a map attached outlining the tax title parcel and (if applicable) the parcel the applicant already owns.

### Step 2:

Once the complete application is received:

- A title report is ordered to verify that the property is truly tax title
- The property is given an assessed value
- The minimum sales price is determined. (Typically, 80% of the assessed value.)

### Step 3:

If the applicant agrees to the minimum sales price:

The application goes through a multi-department review process.

### Step 4:

Once the review is complete:

- An Order of Sale and Resolution are submitted to the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) for approval at a public hearing.
- The BOCC either approves or rejects the sale.

## Step 5:

If approved:

- The Treasurer schedules a public auction and applicants are notified of the date, time, and location. (Anyone can attend the public auction and bid on the parcels for sale.)
- Or the applicant is contacted for a private negotiation. (RCW 36.35.150)

\*\*\*Periodically, the Treasurer's office reviews tax title inventory and may hold a public auction on several tax title properties. The same procedures as above are followed except for the filing of an application. Tax title sales will be listed on the Kitsap County Treasurer Website, if scheduled. \*\*\*
