KITSAP COUNTY, WASHINGTON NOTES TO THE SCHEDULE OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

NOTE 1-BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The Schedule of Financial Assistance is prepared on the same basis of accounting as the County's financial statements. The County uses the modified accrual basis of accounting.

NOTE 2-PROGRAM COSTS

The amounts shown as current year expenditures represent only the state or federal portion of the program costs. Actual program costs, including the County's portion, may be more than shown.

NOTE 3-PROGRAM INCOME

The Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) HOME Program in Kitsap County's Department of Community Development received program income in the amount of \$5,364 in 2000. Under contract #KC 382-95, the County received a payment of \$5,000 for principle and interest plus investment interest. At year-end 2000, accrued interest is in the amount of \$2,080 is not available to the County until the annual payment due date of April 1, 2001.

The County Sheriff's Department has an indirect Federal Department of Justice Grant through the Bureau of Justice program . The purpose of the program is to reduce and prevent illegal drug activity, crime, and violence and to improve the functioning of the criminal justice system. Through this program, the County's drug/narcotic enforcement special unit investigations have generated program income from seizures, forfeitures, and court levied fines per RCW 69.50.505.

NOTE 4-SSWM FISH PASSAGE & PROGRAM CAPITAL FUND PROJECTS

Kitsap County revenue for Fish Passage SSWM Projects, Scandia Creek, Little Bear Creek and Johnson Creek was billed and received after calendar year 1999 as a final billing for the grant. Therefore, it has been recognized as 2000 grant revenue.
