NOTES TO THE SCHEDULE OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

NOTE 1-BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The Schedule of Financial Assistance is prepared on the same basis of accounting as the County's financial statements. The County uses the modified accrual basis of accounting.

NOTE 2-PROGRAM COSTS

The amounts shown as current year expenditures represent only the state or federal portion of the program costs. Actual program costs, including the County's portion, may be more than shown.

NOTE 3-PROGRAM INCOME

The Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) HOME Program in Kitsap County's Department of Community Development received program income in the amount of \$8,332 in 2005 from principal and interest payments with contracts KC 382-95, KC 205-01 and KC 274-02 and investment interest earned. Accrued interest in the amount of \$3,266 is not available to the County until 2006. The City of Bremerton provided program income in the amount of \$6,058 for County administrative costs. The (HUD) Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) had program income of \$81,669 and the HOME Program had program income of \$30,679 received by sub-recipients and is re-allocated for the same program purposes.

The County Sheriff's Department has an indirect Federal Department of Justice Grant through the Bureau of Justice program. The purpose of the program is to reduce and prevent illegal drug activity, crime, and violence and to improve the functioning of the criminal justice system. Through this program, the County's drug/narcotic enforcement special unit investigations have generated program income from seizures, forfeitures, and court levied fines per RCW 69.50.505.

NOTE 4-REVOLVING LOANS

The County has two federal indirect loans from the Environmental Protection Agency, CFDA #66.458. The outstanding balances as of 12/31/05 are \$12,407 for the Gorst Sewer System and \$10,173,093 for the Kingston Sewer System.

NOTE 5-NOT AVAILABLE (N/A)

The County was unable to obtain an identification number.
