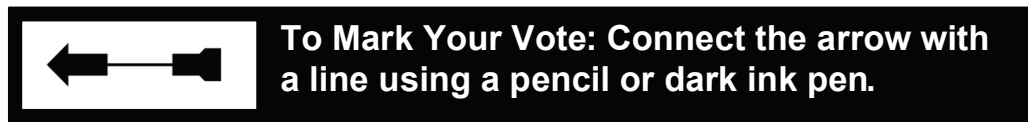


**Sample Ballot**  
**Kitsap County, Washington**  
**Primary – August 7, 2012**



**If you make a mistake:** ~~John Doe~~ ← Draw a line through the entire candidate name or ballot measure response. You have the option of marking another choice if you wish.

To vote for a candidate whose name is **not** on the ballot, write the candidate's name in the space provided and connect the arrow.

Unless specifically allowed by law, more than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted.

**Note to voters:** This ballot contains all measures and races that will appear on the August 7<sup>th</sup> Primary ballot. Only the ballot issues that apply to the precinct where you are registered to vote will appear on your ballot.

**Bremerton School District No. 100-C**

**Proposition No. 1**  
**Facilities Capital Projects Levy**

The Board of Directors of Bremerton School District No. 100-C adopted Resolution 2011/2012-14 concerning a proposition for a capital projects levy. This proposition authorizes the District to undertake major roof repairs to schools and facilities, upgrade computer technologies, replace the central kitchen facility, add classrooms to West Hills STEM, and upgrade fire alarm systems; and authorizes the following excess levies for such purposes on all taxable property within the District:
