Overview - Kitsap County Shoreline Master Program Periodic Review

- Periodic review required every eight years Due June 30, 2021
- First periodic review since comprehensive update in 2014
- Joint Kitsap County Planning Commission and Washington Department of Ecology public hearing and comment period
- Board of County Commissioners public hearing and comment period

Purpose of a Shoreline Master Program Periodic Review

01

Align the SMP with applicable state laws and guidelines in effect at the time of the review;

02

Assure consistency of the SMP with the County's comprehensive plan and development regulations; and


03

Provide clarifications to improve usability and predictability of the SMP for applicants and reviewers.

The periodic review process:

- does not include review of ecological functions and baseline conditions
- does not include changes to shoreline jurisdiction or environmental designations
- <u>does not</u> include changes to shoreline maps
